He restores my soul.	Jesus rests and invites to rest (1:35 & 6:31)
He leads me in paths of righteousness	Jesus teaches – righteousness (6:34)
For His name’s	Jesus’ name gained reputation (6:14)
Sake.	Jesus points to Father (8:38, 11:25, 14:36)
Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,	(A) Jesus pauses to mourn death... (6:29)
I will fear no evil, for you are with me;	Jesus is present, so do not fear (6:50)
Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.	(B) Jesus empowers others (with a “staff”)...
You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies	(A) ...From a feast (“banquet”) (6:21-29)
You anoint my head with oil;	(B) ...and “anointing oil” (6:7-13)
My cup overflows.	Jesus gives abundantly (6:43 & 8:8)
Surely goodness	Jesus is and does “good” (3:4, 4:20, & 10:17+)
And mercy shall follow me all the days of my life,	Jesus represents God’s mercy (5:19-20)
And I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.	Jesus’ presence and authority in the “house” of God (11:11-27, 12:35, 14:58, 15:38)
