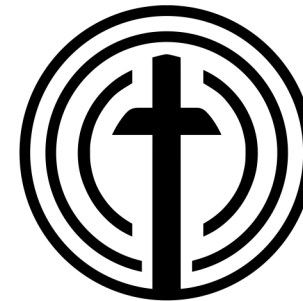
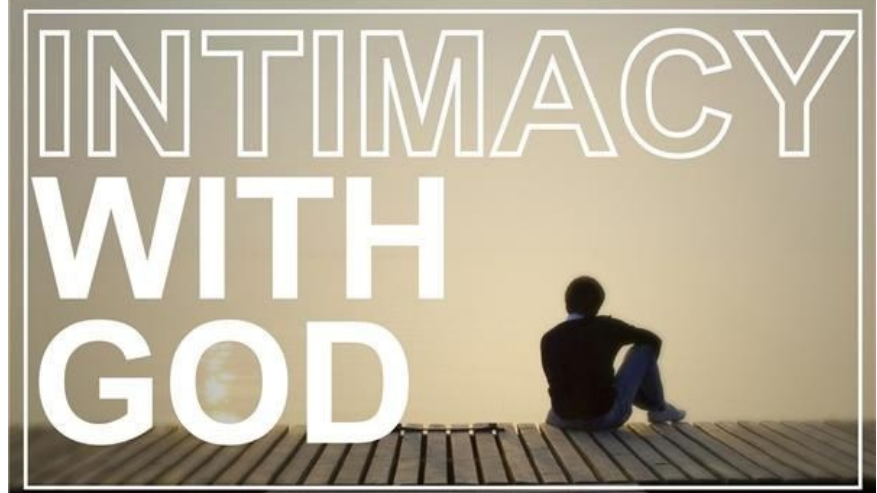
Prayer Meeting
