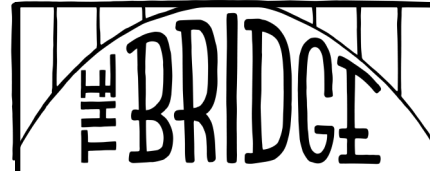
Church Business Meeting is Wednesday, April 28th at 6 PM—8 PM. Dinner will be served.
