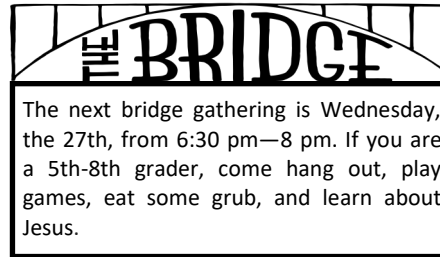


There will be no Youth Group tonight due to Fall Break.
