Little Friends Day Care & Preschool is Hiring!

Little Friends Day Care & Preschool is currently hiring for two open positions: Toddler Provider (full-time) & School Age Care Giver/Floater (part-time). **Toddler Provider:** Little Friends has an immediate opening for an assistant in our toddler classroom. Candidates must be at least 21 years of age and



have a high school diploma. Preference will be given to someone with a CDA or Early Childhood or equivalent degree along with experience working with toddlers. Candidates will also be considered if they are willing to obtain an Infant/Toddler CDA. Candidates must be willing to implement lesson plans for toddlers under the guidance of the lead teacher and must be willing to be trained in Safe Sleep practices and other topics related to the health, safety and education of young children. Candidates must also follow all state laws regarding to child care. This is a five day a week position with approximately 35 to 40 hours per week with occasional evening day care and training events. School Age Care **Giver/Floater:** Little Friends has an immediate part time opening for a school age caregiver/floater during the afternoon and after school hours, on school cancellation days, school breaks and holidays. Candidates must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma. Preference will be given to someone with experience working with school age children. Applicant must also be willing to help with daily cleaning tasks and assist in other classrooms as needed throughout the facility. Candidates must be willing to plan for activities for school age children, assist children with homework after school and on e-learning days, give daily breaks as needed to other classroom staff, perform daily cleaning tasks and be open to other duties as needed. Applicant must be willing to comply with all state regulations regarding a registered child care ministry including a drug screen, background checks and ongoing training activities. This is a five day a week position with approximately 25 to 30 hours per week with occasional evening day care and training events. Applications for both positions may be picked up at Little Friends Day Care Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. A resume and references must be included with the application when it is submitted.
