We are looking at what it means to be a warrior for Christ and the battles we can face and win with Jesus in our corner. The last message in this series, on June 27th will deal with the battle being waged in our hearts and culture when it comes to pornography. This will happen in both our Sunday morning services. The many negative effects of pornography consumption have been scientifically researched and documented.

Abuse in the industry itself is rampant. Clicking on these videos and images hurts more than just ourselves as well. In a very real way, with every click, you prop up sex trafficking, rape, and coercion. Yet, according to a 2020 study, **91% of men and 60% of women regularly consume pornography.** While I will be careful to be tactful and not explicit in my message, I will be engaging this subject directly. Please help get the word out. If this could be upsetting or triggering for you, know that we love you and support your decision to take a pass on this one. Some of you might feel that you're ready to engage this topic with your kids and this could be a good jumping off point for that discussion. Others may feel that this is not currently an appropriate topic for their children to grapple with. We respect both decisions and recognize that it is yours to make. With that in mind, we wanted to make sure everyone knows this is coming and can adjust their plans accordingly.
