Week 2: A Story of Perfect Timing Galatians 4:4-7

Big Idea for this week:
God gave Jesus to us at the perfect time

1. Perfect timing requires patience

2. Perfect timing requires trust

These questions are designed to extend the impact of the Sunday gathering. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family, and/or with your Life Group.

1. Have you ever experienced being at the right place at the right time? What was the circumstance? How did you feel?

2. What is the most difficult part about waiting? Has there ever been a time when you wondered whether God was actually at work in a season of waiting, only to find out later that He was? What happened?

3. It's important not to waste our waiting. What do you think that looks like, practically? What are some ways you can lean on God and trust what He's doing in the middle of your waiting? How is God teaching you patience and trust in your waiting?

Share the Truth. Patience and trust are virtues that seem lost in our culture today. And waiting on God seems almost as difficult. We all know someone who feels like God isn't coming through. Pray for opportunities to show that God always comes through at the perfect time. And when God gives you an opportunity to share, it, be obedient and share the truth.

Ask yourself. Am I patient with God's timing? Do I trust Him when it doesn't feel like He's working? How can I believe that His timing is perfect?

Prayer: Father, thank You for what You're doing. You have a plan for each of our lives and You always come through at the perfect time. Help me when I am impatient and to trust the plan You have for me. Help me to lean on You during times of waiting. In Jesus' Name, amen.
