



Week 4: I'm Invested In God's Future 2 Corinthians 8:10-11 Message Notes

Big Idea for this week: The church needs spiritual entrepreneurs

1. The Church has succeeded because of spiritual entrepreneurs

2. The Church needs spiritual entrepreneurs now more than ever

These questions are designed to extend the impact of the Sunday gathering. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family, and/or with your Life Group.

1. Have you ever started a business or known someone who started a business? What are some things that would be exciting about that? What are some things that would make you nervous?

2. How do you feel when someone is excited about something that you are excited about? Are you excited about the church? Are you excited about the possibilities the church has to invest in and influence people?

3. What do you think is the church's vision? What do you think it will take to see the Great Commission fulfilled? Do you see yourself as a spiritual entrepreneur? What part will you play in the future of our church?

Share the Truth. The church was built on people who had a big vision for the message of Jesus. God calls us all to invest in the future of the church. The church honestly needs spiritual entrepreneurs. Has God put someone in your life that God is calling you to share hope with and to personally invest in deeply?

Ask yourself. How is God calling me to be a spiritual entrepreneur? How is God calling me to play a part in Christ Community as an entrepreneur? Is it through my giving? Through my serving? Through my encouragement? How?
