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## SMALL GROUP AND DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

*These questions are designed to extend the impact of the Sunday gathering. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family, and/or with your Life Group*

1. Which part of the message was most impactful for you and why? Which part of this passage is easiest for you? The hardest?

5. We said, “Our identity is not in our changing circumstances but in God’s unchanging character.” How does knowing God loves you with an unending love change the way you see your worth? What comfort does it bring knowing God’s character?
6. The Lord is my shepherd who knows me by name. Each day this week, find new ways to fill in the following sentence:
