Big Idea: fuels

These questions are designed to extend the impact of the Sunday gathering. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family, and/or with your Life Group.

1. Have you learned any of your neighbors' names this week? What are they? Which neighbors are you planning to visit next?

2. Take a moment to think about how God has been faithful to you. Can you think of 1 or 2 specific instances where God proved His faithfulness to you? Share that with someone this week.

3. We all think we need to do more of something to prove ourselves to God and win His approval. It's in our old nature. But what is God teaching you about how you show your gratefulness to God?

4. Micah says that God requires His children to *act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly*. Which of these is easiest for you? Hardest? Why do you think that is?

5. What is one thing you can do this week to love where you live? Be specific and pray about it this week.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, You have blessed me in so many ways. Would You please help me to be truly grateful for Your faithfulness in my life. Help me to remember that I don't have to prove myself to You, but simply live my life honoring to You, sharing Your hope with those around me. In Jesus' Name, amen.
