1. Have you learned any of your neighbors' names this week? What are they? Which neighbors are you planning to visit next?

2. 2 Corinthians 5 is an exciting passage for all followers of Jesus. It reminds us of who we used to be and who we are now. And it's simply because of Jesus. Take a few moments right now to thank God for Jesus and for His great salvation in your life.

3. God calls us His ambassador. What do ambassadors do? How do we bring the message of reconciliation to the unsaved? How does that make you feel?

4. These next questions may take some thought. How is God reshaping you for Himself? How is God refocusing you for others? How is God repurposing you for His message? How does God want to use you to share your transformed life with others?

5. What is one thing you can do this week to love where you live? Be specific and pray about it this week.
