## My Story Discussion Questions – Part 7 June 23

These questions are designed to extend the impact of the Sunday gathering. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family, and/or with your Life Group.

1. Which part of the message was most impactful for you and why? Which part of this passage is easiest for you? Hardest?

2. Why do you think people generally struggle with faithfulness? Do you think with all of the options and all the opportunities that we have in our world, it's easy to just "move on to the next thing"? Why do you think this could be harmful? Is it harmful?

3. In what ways has God been faithful to you? Do you see yourself worthy of that faithfulness? Do you think this matters?

4. In our text for today, Jesus tells a parable about 3 servants. Many of us have heard this parable before. How do we be intentional with the things that God has called us to? How do we as Jesus-followers avoid the draw of settling? What do you think could be the outcome of living with intentionality rather than settling?

5. Our big idea for the week is: You are perfectly positioned to perform the task for which God has purposed, if you do not give up. What are some specific things you can do to 1) realize this to be true in your life, and 2) not give up when things get difficult?

6. What is one area that you are relying on the Holy Spirit to let faithfulness live through you? How are you going to live a faithful life to the things that matter most this week?

Prayer: Holy Spirit, we pray to You for help. I need Your power to live a faithful, intentional life every day. Please help me to experience Your great faithfulness in my life. Let me be Your light and bring hope to those I meet because I am not settling for things that don't really matter. Thank You for living inside me. In Your Name, Jesus. Amen.
