

## Jesus' Boot Camp John 14,15,16,17: We Are One. (Week 1)

### John chapter 14

contains several key themes and teachings of Jesus that provide comfort and guidance to His disciples.

1. **\*\*Don't be Troubled: (John 14:1-3)\*\***: Preparation before the storm comes, A farmer hires a worker because in the interview he said that he can sleep through a storm!
2. **\*\*The Way to the Father (John 14:4-6)\*\***: Jesus tells them that they know the way to where He is going. **Thomas expresses confusion**, and Jesus clarifies that He is **"the way, and the truth, and the life,"** emphasizing that no one comes to the Father except through Him.
3. **\*\*Knowing the Father (John 14:7-11)\*\***: Jesus explains that by knowing Him, they know the Father. He urges them to believe that He is in the Father and the Father is in Him, showing that His words and works reflect God's will and nature.
4. **\*\*Promise of Greater Works (John 14:12)\*\***: Jesus promises that those who believe in Him will do the works He has been doing, and even greater works because He is going to the Father.
5. **\*\*Prayer in His Name (John 14:13-14)\*\***: He encourages His disciples to ask for anything in His name, promising that He will do it to glorify the Father through the Son.

### Part 2 John 14

1. **\*\* If You Love Me (John 14:15-21)\*\***I will Keep His commandments, And Father will give me HS, and we will be one, Jesus is starting the handoff from home selves to the Father and HS.
2. **\*\*Qualifications for Roommates (John 14:22-25)** And WE will make our home with the one that loves and obeys the words of Jesus.
3. **\*\* The Hand off from Jesus to Father and HOLY SPIRIT John 14:26-29)\*\***. **Jesus** tells the story that he will be leaving but we are not going to be alone, We will have all 3 living inside of us. He said do not be troubled, and that we should be rejoicing that this is happening and not sorrowful. And he plainly said he was telling them before this happens..
4. **\*\* The Ruler of this World is coming John 14: 30-31)\*\***. Jesus said that he was not going to talk much because the ruler of this world was coming. Satan was about to over play his hand. I was to put on display that Jesus Loved the Father and the world would not have an excuse to not believe. .

This chapter as a whole is a reminder of Jesus' love, His role as the only way to God, and His assurance of eternal life for believers. It emphasizes trust in Him, the power of prayer, and the intimate relationship between Jesus and the Father and a completed remodel of the temple they are wanting to move into.

## *I Am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life*

**John 14:1** <sup>d</sup>“Let not your hearts be troubled. <sup>e</sup>Believe in God; <sup>1</sup>believe also in me. <sup>2</sup>In <sup>f</sup>my Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that <sup>g</sup>I go to prepare a place for you? <sup>3</sup>And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you <sup>h</sup>to myself, that <sup>i</sup>where I am you may be also. <sup>4</sup>And you know the way to where I am going.”<sup>3</sup>

<sup>5</sup>Thomas said to him, “Lord, <sup>k</sup>we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?” <sup>6</sup>Jesus said to him, “I am <sup>l</sup>the way, and <sup>m</sup>the truth, and <sup>n</sup>the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. <sup>7</sup><sup>o</sup>If you had known me, you would have <sup>p</sup>known my Father also. <sup>4</sup>From now on you do know him and <sup>q</sup>have seen him.”

**John 14:8** <sup>r</sup>Philip said to him, “Lord, <sup>s</sup>show us the Father, and it is enough for us.” <sup>9</sup>Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? <sup>t</sup>Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’? <sup>10</sup>Do you not believe that <sup>u</sup>I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you <sup>v</sup>I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works. <sup>11</sup>Believe me that <sup>w</sup>I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else <sup>x</sup>believe on account of the works themselves.

**John 14:12** “Truly, truly, I say to you, <sup>y</sup>whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I <sup>z</sup>am going to the Father. <sup>13</sup><sup>z</sup>Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that <sup>a</sup>the Father may be glorified in the Son. <sup>14</sup><sup>z</sup>If you ask me <sup>5</sup>anything in my name, I will do it.



**John 14:15** <sup>b</sup>"If you love me, you will <sup>c</sup>keep my commandments. <sup>16</sup> And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another <sup>d</sup>Helper, <sup>e</sup>to be with you forever, <sup>17</sup> even <sup>e</sup>the Spirit of truth, <sup>f</sup>whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and <sup>g</sup>will be <sup>7</sup>in you.

**John 14:18** "I will not leave you as orphans; <sup>h</sup>I will come to you. <sup>19</sup> Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but <sup>i</sup>you will see me. <sup>k</sup>Because I live, you also will live. <sup>20</sup> In that day you will know that <sup>m</sup>I am in my Father, and <sup>n</sup>you in me, and <sup>o</sup>I in you. <sup>21</sup> Whoever has my commandments and <sup>q</sup>keeps them, he it is who loves me. And <sup>r</sup>he who loves me <sup>s</sup>will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and <sup>t</sup>manifest myself to him." <sup>22</sup> Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, "Lord, how is it <sup>v</sup>that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?" <sup>23</sup> Jesus answered him, <sup>w</sup>"If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and <sup>x</sup>we will come to him and <sup>y</sup>make our home with him. <sup>24</sup> Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And <sup>z</sup>the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me.

**John 14:25** "These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. <sup>26</sup> But the <sup>a</sup>Helper, the Holy Spirit, <sup>b</sup>whom the Father will send in my name, <sup>c</sup>he will teach you all things and <sup>d</sup>bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. <sup>27</sup> Peace I leave with you; <sup>e</sup>my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. <sup>f</sup>Let not your hearts be troubled, neither <sup>g</sup>let them be afraid. <sup>28</sup> You heard me say to you, <sup>h</sup>"I am going away, and I will come to you." If you loved me, you would have rejoiced, because I <sup>i</sup>am going to the Father, for <sup>j</sup>the Father is greater than I. <sup>29</sup> And <sup>k</sup>now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe. <sup>30</sup> I will no longer talk much with you, for <sup>l</sup>the ruler of this world is coming. <sup>m</sup>He has no claim on me, <sup>31</sup> but I do <sup>n</sup>as the Father has commanded me, <sup>o</sup>so that the world may know that I love the Father. Rise, let us go from here.
