Mark 11 the keys to Power

- For assuredly, I say to you, whoever **says** to this mountain, “Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, **he will have whatever he says.** Mark 11:23
- Therefore I say to you, whatever things you **ask** when you pray, **believe** that you **receive** them, and you will have them. Mark 11:24
- Receive what you say. When you believe what you ask -when you pray.

The Colt

Mark 11:1-10

- Now when they drew near Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, He sent two of His disciples; and He said to them, “Go into the village opposite you; and as soon as you have entered it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has sat. Loose it and bring it. And if anyone says to you, Why are you doing this?’ say, ‘**The Lord has need of it**, and immediately he will send it here.(back to you) Mark11:1-3
- 1 Samuel 6:7-12: When you carry the Glory you are at peace.

- So they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door outside on the street, and they loosed it. But some of those who stood there said to them, “What are you doing, loosing the colt? And they spoke to them **just as Jesus had commanded**. So they let them go. Mark 11:4-6
- Loosed by Grace: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Romans 3:23-24
- And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, **for the former things have passed away.**” Rev 21:4

- Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their clothes on it, and He sat on it. And many spread their clothes on the road, and others cut down leafy branches from the trees and spread them on the road. Then those who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: “Hosanna! ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!’ Blessed is the **kingdom** of our father David That comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest ! Mark 11:7-10

The Temple

- And Jesus went into Jerusalem and into the temple. **So when He had looked around at all things**, as the hour was already late, He went out to Bethany with the twelve. Mark 11:11
- For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him. In this you have done foolishly; therefore from now on you shall have wars. 2 Chron. 16:9

- So they came to Jerusalem. Then Jesus went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves. And He would not allow anyone to carry wares through the temple. Then He taught, saying to them, “Is it not written, “My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations’? But you have made it a ‘den of thieves.’ And the scribes and chief priests heard it and sought how they might destroy Him; for they feared Him, because all the people were astonished at His teaching. When evening had come, He went out of the city. Mark 11:15-19

A Clean Temple is a must !!

- John 2:12-16: Jesus did this at the beginning of his ministry and the end.

You are the Temple of God!

- Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, **which temple you are.** 1 Cor.3:16-17

The Fig Tree

- Now the next day, when they had come out from Bethany, He was hungry. And seeing from afar a fig tree having leaves, He went to see if perhaps He would find something on it. When He came to it, He found nothing but leaves, for it was not the season for figs. In response Jesus said to it, **“Let no one eat fruit from you ever again.** And His disciples heard it. Mark 11:12-14
- ~~And it is a wonder why a fig tree planted in his vineyard? But he saw some figs and did not find any, so he said to the keeper of his vineyard, “If you see any figs, come and pick them for me.” But he answered him, “No, sir, it is not the season for figs.”~~ Luke 13:6-9

- Now in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. And Peter, remembering, said to Him, “Rabbi, look! **The fig tree which You cursed has withered away.** So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God. Mark 11:20-22

Why did Jesus Curse the Fig Tree

- Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings. Genesis 3:7

When the mountain will not move!

- And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, **forgive him**, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. Mark 11:25
- But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses. Mark 11:26
