"True" Identity produces power to kill or give life.

Identity:

talk about Christ in you. His history is my history.

Romans 8:11 "If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you."

Romans 8:11 ESV

What lies behind you and what lies in front of you, pales in comparison to what lies inside of you..

Identity If you don't see yourself as a winner, then you cannot perform as a winner.

Aim at heaven and you will get earth thrown in. Aim at earth and you get neither.

Maturity is proven by listening to almost anything without losing your temper or yourself confidence

Don't judge each day by the harvest you reap, but by the seeds that you plant. (ask for crop failure on bad seeds of your past)

Perfection is not attainable, but if we chase the perfection within us, we can catch Excellence.

Until you feel the pain of Grace God will not release the power of Grace to you.

I didn't ask you to defend the Church and its behavior, I asked you to cover it, Hugh Difference and takes relationship and commitment.

Frustration is a tool of God to mold you into His image.

Until the pain of staying the same becomes greater than the pain of change! we want!

The next level of maturity: Transparency VS Vulnerability

Transparency lets others see your humanity; Vulnerability lets them touch it. That's when a transfer of power is exchanged.
