DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. What first comes to mind when you hear the word repent? What does it mean to truly repent? What are some misunderstandings of repentance in our day?
3. Thinking about the role of repentance in your life, does your life look any different than it did one year ago? If so, how? How have your interests, goals, and/or desires in life changed?
4. The disciples left everything and followed Jesus immediately. Would you drop everything, give up income, leave your family for months, and/or leave a company behind to follow Jesus? Why or why not?
5. Why did Jesus Christ pair his preaching of the word with the healing of the sicknesses and wounds of his followers?
6. What hope does being a part of the Kingdom of God through Christ bring a person in our day?
