INTRODUCTION

The four Gospel writers (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) give a testimony of the life and ministry of Jesus with their own particular perspective. John completes the four-sided testimony of Jesus in the Gospels. He writes so that anyone who believes that Jesus is the Son of God may have eternal life in His name.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is something you believe that maybe you don't share with many people? (i.e. conspiracy theories, Big Foot, etc. Have fun with this one)
2. What do you believe that God wants from you?
3. What are some "signs" you have witnessed in your life or the life of those around you that help you believe in God?
4. What is an exclusive club that you would love to be a part of?
5. Is there anything about Jesus that you find hard to believe in? If so, what?
6. Read John 3:16–17. What are some reasons it can be difficult for us to believe that God loves us so much he sent Jesus to die for us? Why is it sometimes easier to believe that God condemns us?
7. What is one thing you can do this week to embrace the truth that God loves you, that he gave his only Son on your behalf, and that all you have to do is believe in Jesus and receive that gift? How can this group support you?
