INTRODUCTION

The word "evangelism" carries baggage for a lot of people. Dave explains that sharing the Gospel doesn't have to be stressful or mysterious. Find out why telling your story of what you have seen, heard, and experienced of Jesus is the best way to reach people far from God.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When you hear the word "evangelism," is what comes to mind positive or negative? Why?
2. Who is a Christ follower in your life whose faith you admire? What is it about how that person lives that you admire?
3. Talk about a time when someone shared his or her faith with you. Did that person defend a Christian worldview, the Bible, or church doctrine, or did that person explain his or her personal hope in Jesus? How did you respond?
4. Read 1 John 1:1-4. What have you heard, seen, looked at, and/or touched that you can proclaim concerning Jesus?
5. During the message, Dave said, "Evangelism is joining a conversation God is already having with someone." How does that idea change your perspective about what it looks like to share your faith?
6. What can you do this week to begin to craft a simple statement about the resurrection that answers the question, "Why are you a follower of Jesus?" What can this group do to help you?
