4. On a scale of 1 to 10 how busy is your life right now? When was the last "slow" season? How can you slow down to hear and answer God's calling for you?
5. Caleb mentioned 3 areas God can call us out of – sin, comfort, hurry – which of these is most difficult to leave behind? Why?
6. What is God calling you out of and how can you make sure you really leave it behind?
