4. Have you ever seen someone who was suffering extraordinarily but demonstrated extraordinary confidence in God? If so, how did it change the way you think about suffering and faith?
5. "Why doesn't God do something about _____?" What do you typically put in that blank? How often do you ask that question?
6. Read Luke 18:7-8. Is it difficult for you to believe God will one day bring about justice in the world? Why or why not?
