Matthew 21:23-27

"The baptism of John was from what source, from heaven or from men?" And they began reasoning among themselves, saying, "If we say, 'From heaven,' He will say to us, 'Then why did you not believe him?' But if we say, 'From men,' we fear the crowd; for they all regard John as a prophet." And they answered Jesus and said, "We do not know." He also said to them, "Neither will I tell you by what authority I do these things."

Spiritual Authority

- A divine power from God to lead, teach, and influence others to grow.
- God commissioned Jesus to come to the earth with authority to destroy the works of the devil.
- We can't be commissioned until we come under submission to the primary mission.

He said that, among the Gentiles, men seek for authority in order that they may rule over others. It is good for us to seek for the future glory, but we ought not have the thought of ruling or lording it over God's

1. Submit yourselves

- <u>James 4:7</u> Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Submit to God
- Hupotasso- to come under one in higher authority voluntarily.
- Submit to your leaders

Hebrews 13:17

Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority, because they keep watch over you as those who must give an account. Do this so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no benefit to you.

2. Humble yourselves

- James 4:10 humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.
- Humility is a proper perspective of oneself in reference to God.
