

The Sound of His Voice

How can I develop my ability to hear God's voice better?

Habakkuk 2:1-2

I will stand at my guard post, and station myself on the watchtower; and I will keep watch to see what He will say to me...Then the Lord answered me and said, "Write down the revelation, and inscribe it clearly on tablets, so that one who reads it may run."



- 1. Sound of His voice
- 2. Stand at my guard post
- 3. Keep watch to see
- 4. Write down the revelation

What does His voice sound like?

- It sounds like a spontaneous, intersecting thought.
- The Holy Spirit is speaking directly to my spirit.

Thoughts from my mind are analytical, cognitive, reasoned.

Thoughts from my heart are spontaneous. They interrupt/intersect the thoughts from my mind.

Paga

- to meet together; join; intersect
- God causes His thoughts to meet/join/ intersect with our thoughts.
- A divine word / thought that intersects with our thoughts.

Once you get this, you begin to know what to listen for to hear His voice.
