Part 1: The Power of Grace

- Grace is God's ability at work in us.
- The Flesh is depending on our own ability.
- Matthew 11:28-29 – “Come to Me, all who are weary and burdened....Take My yoke....”
- John 1:14 – “....full of grace...”
- John 1:16 – “of His fullness we have all received, and grace upon grace”

Part 2: Conquering Sin

- Romans 6:14 – “Sin no longer has dominion over you, for you are....under grace.
- When we were Born Again, we left the realm of the Law, where it depended on our ability.
- Vigilant & Sober-Minded.
- God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.

Part 3: Reigning Grace

- Works Righteousness
- Romans 8:3 – “For what the law was power-less to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending His own Son....”
- Faith Righteousness

Philippians 3:9

And be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ – the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith.

Romans 5:17

For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.

Romans 6:1-3 (The Message)

So what do we do? Keep on sinning so God can keep on forgiving? I should hope not! If we've left the country where sin is sovereign, how can we still live in our old house there? Or didn't you realize we packed up and left there for good? That is what happened in baptism. When we went under the water, we left the old country of sin behind; when we came up out of the water, we entered into the new country of grace—a new life in a new land!
