I KEEP MY EYES WIDE OPEN

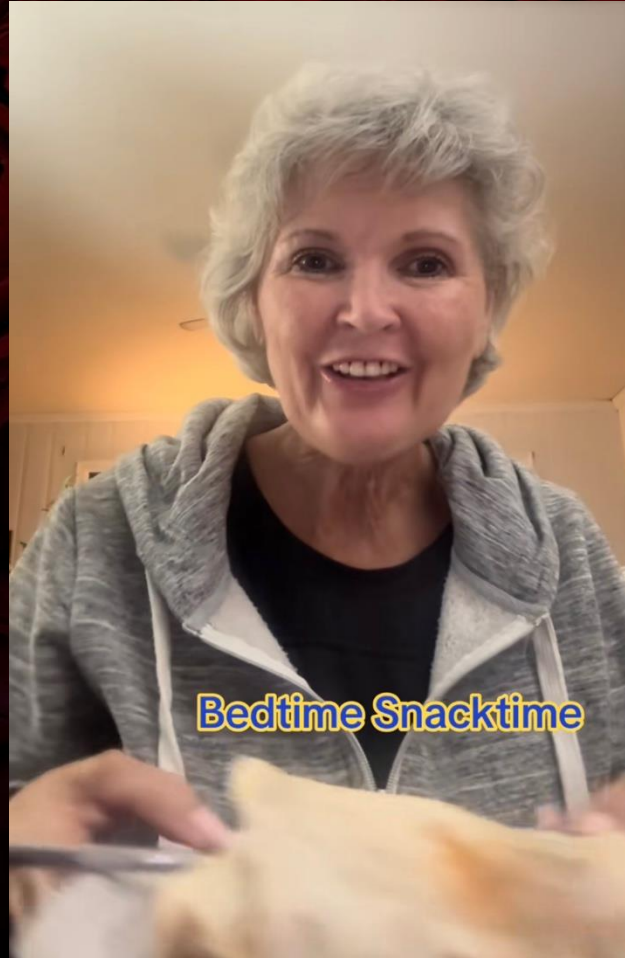
Proverbs 29:18 KJV
