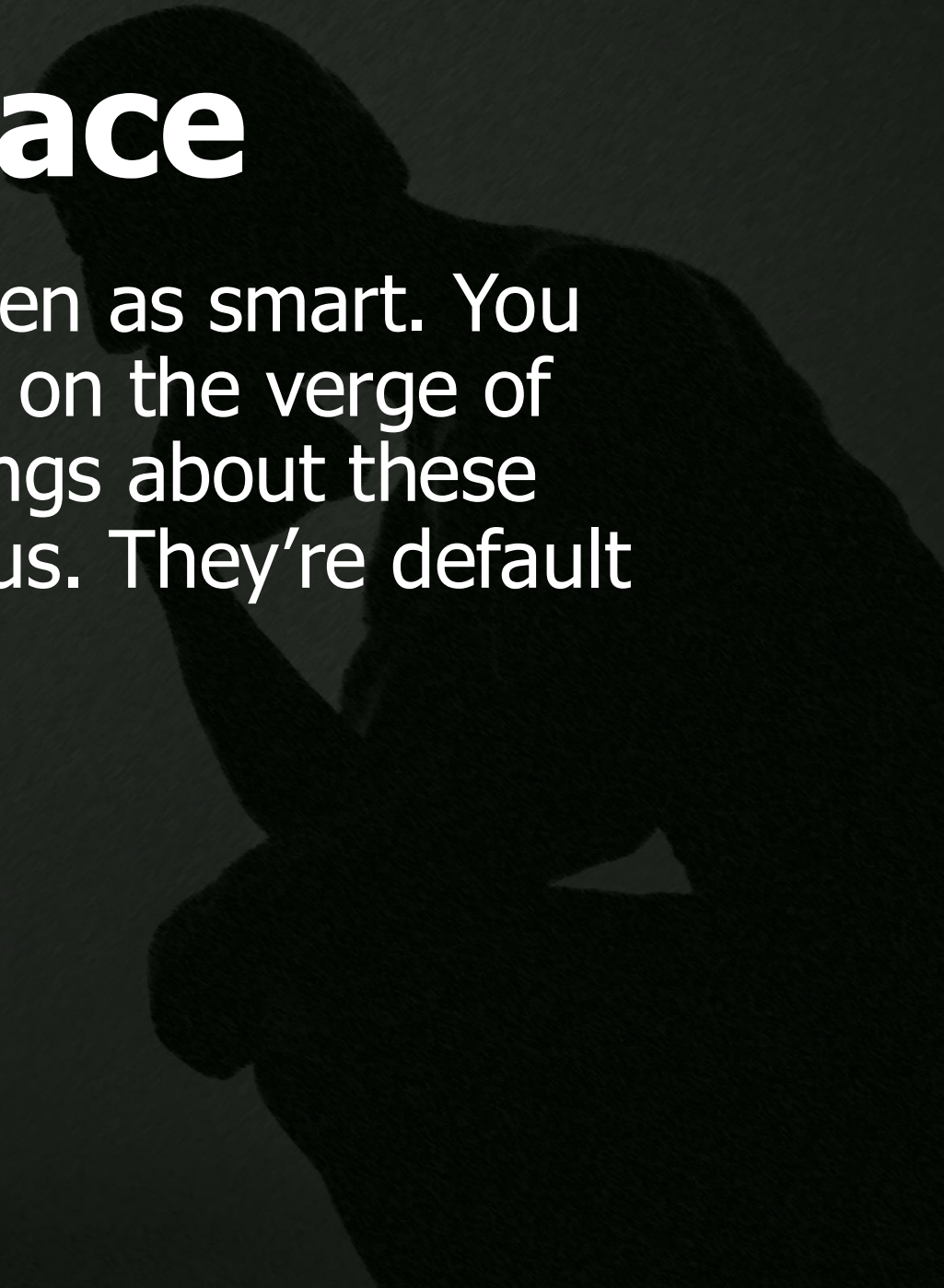
# David Foster Wallace

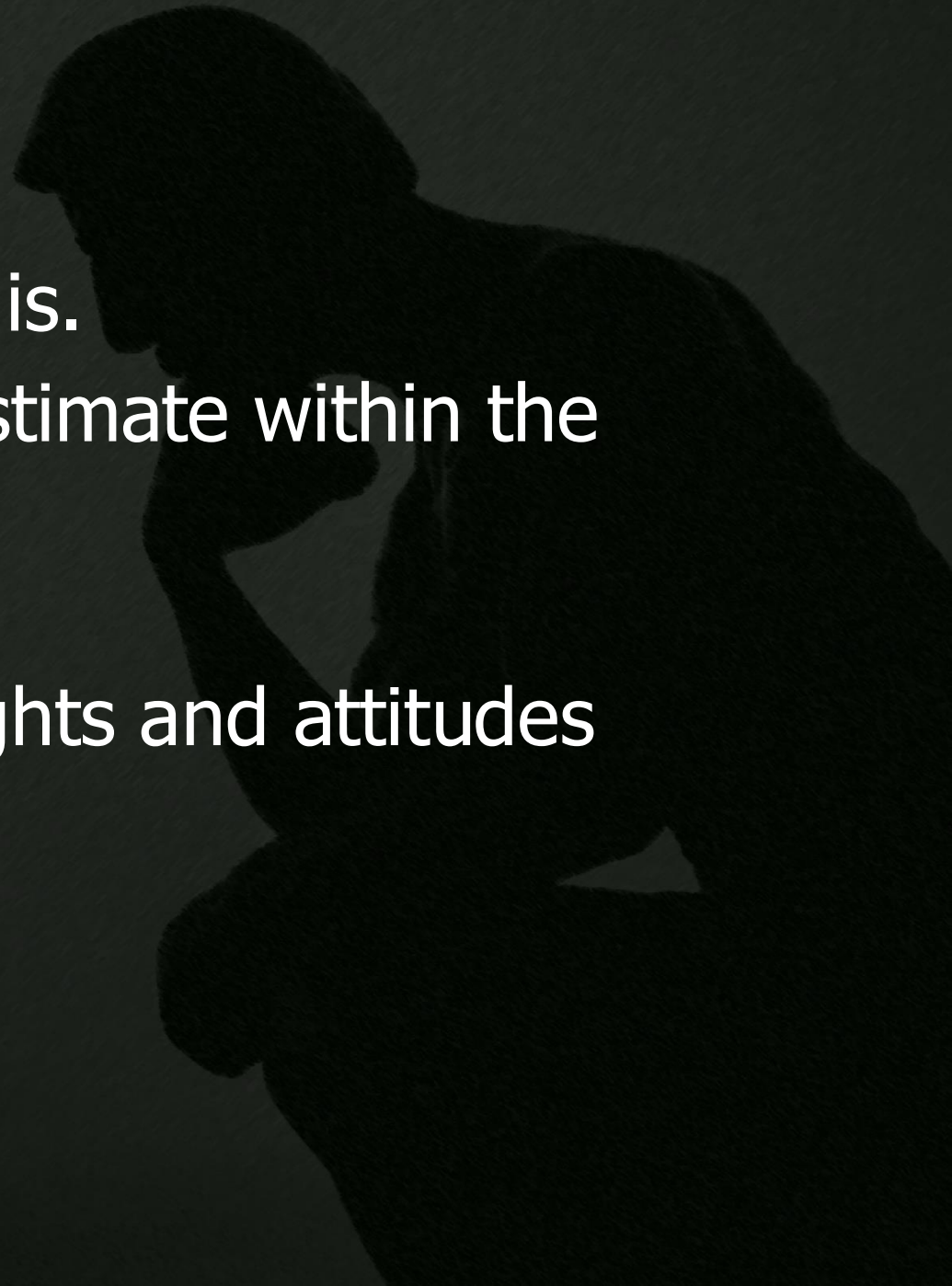

As a man thinketh in his heart, so he is.

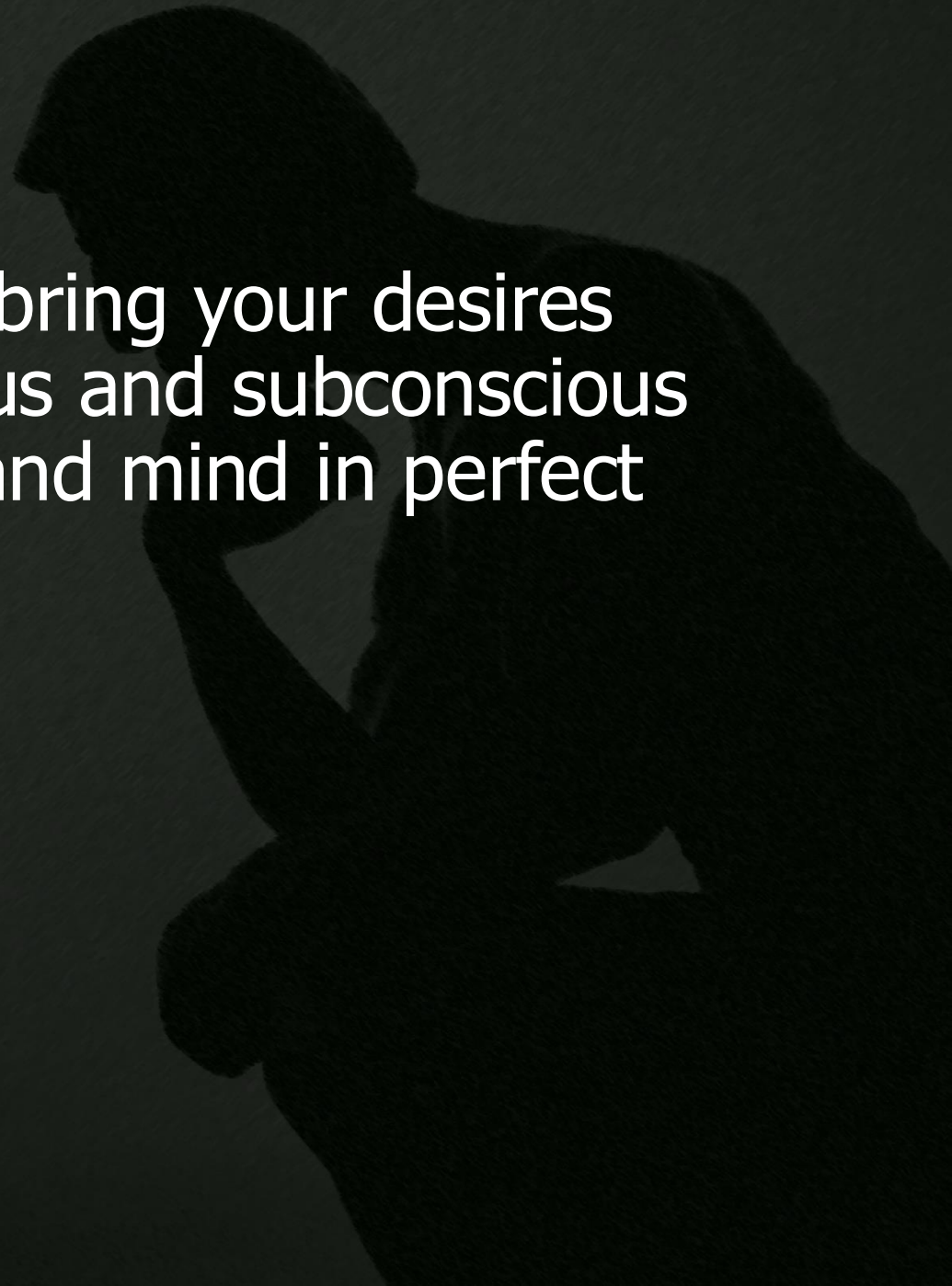
- Thinketh- Hebrew; to calculate or estimate within the heart.

- Our subconscious mind where thoughts and attitudes reside, but we're not conscious of it.





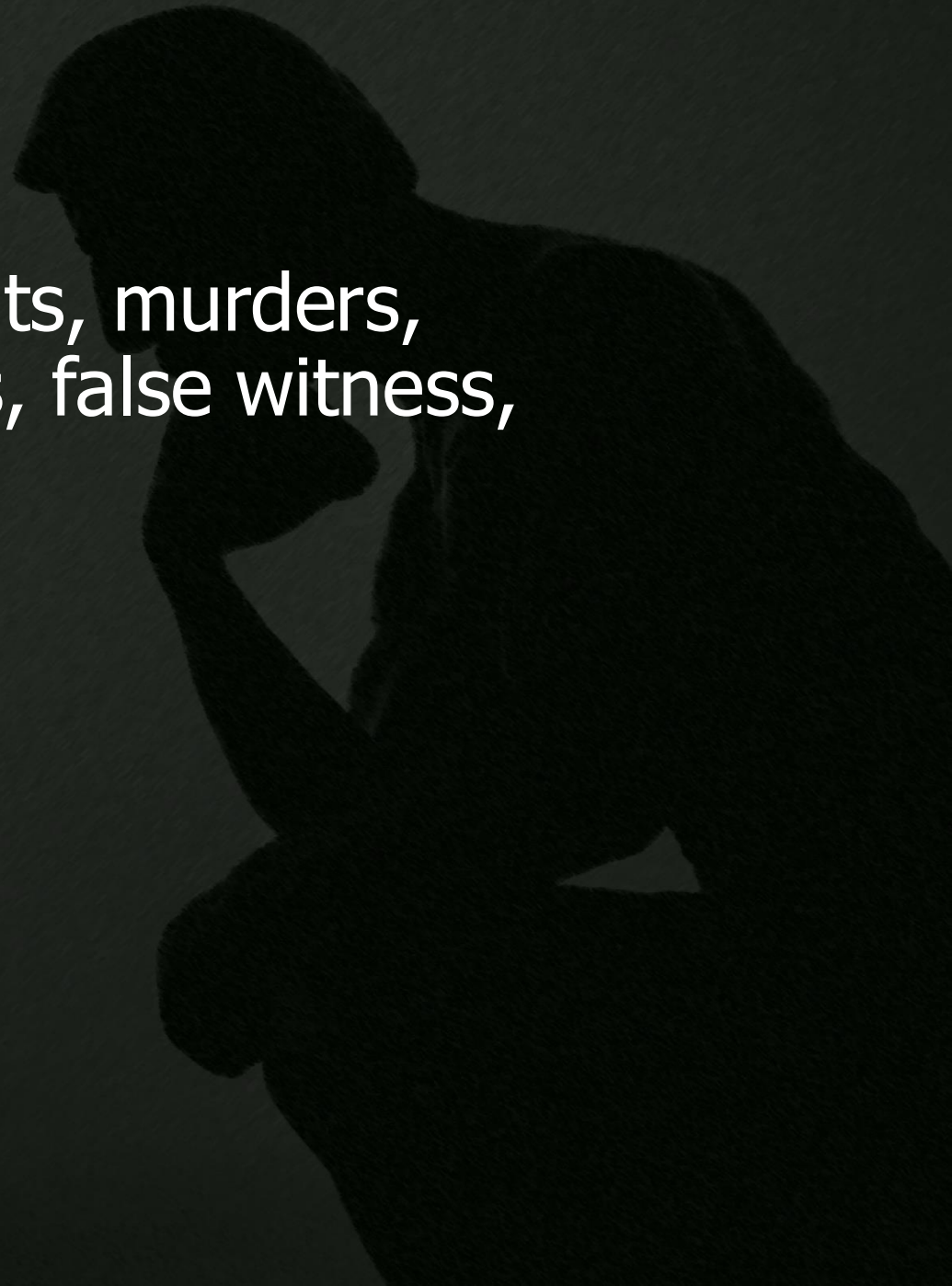

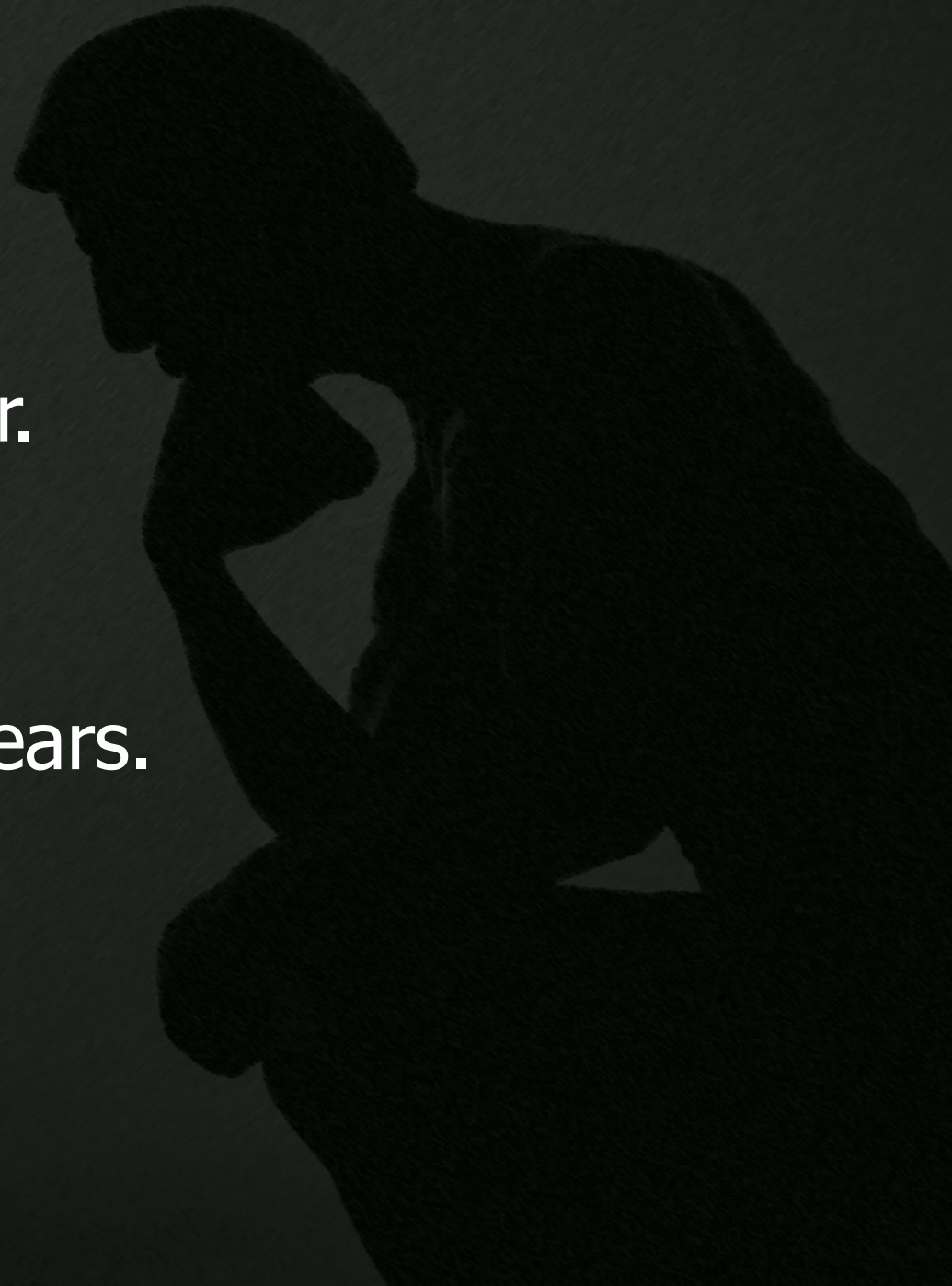
# 1. Hear the Word

Let these words sink down into your ears.






# 2. Meditate on the Word

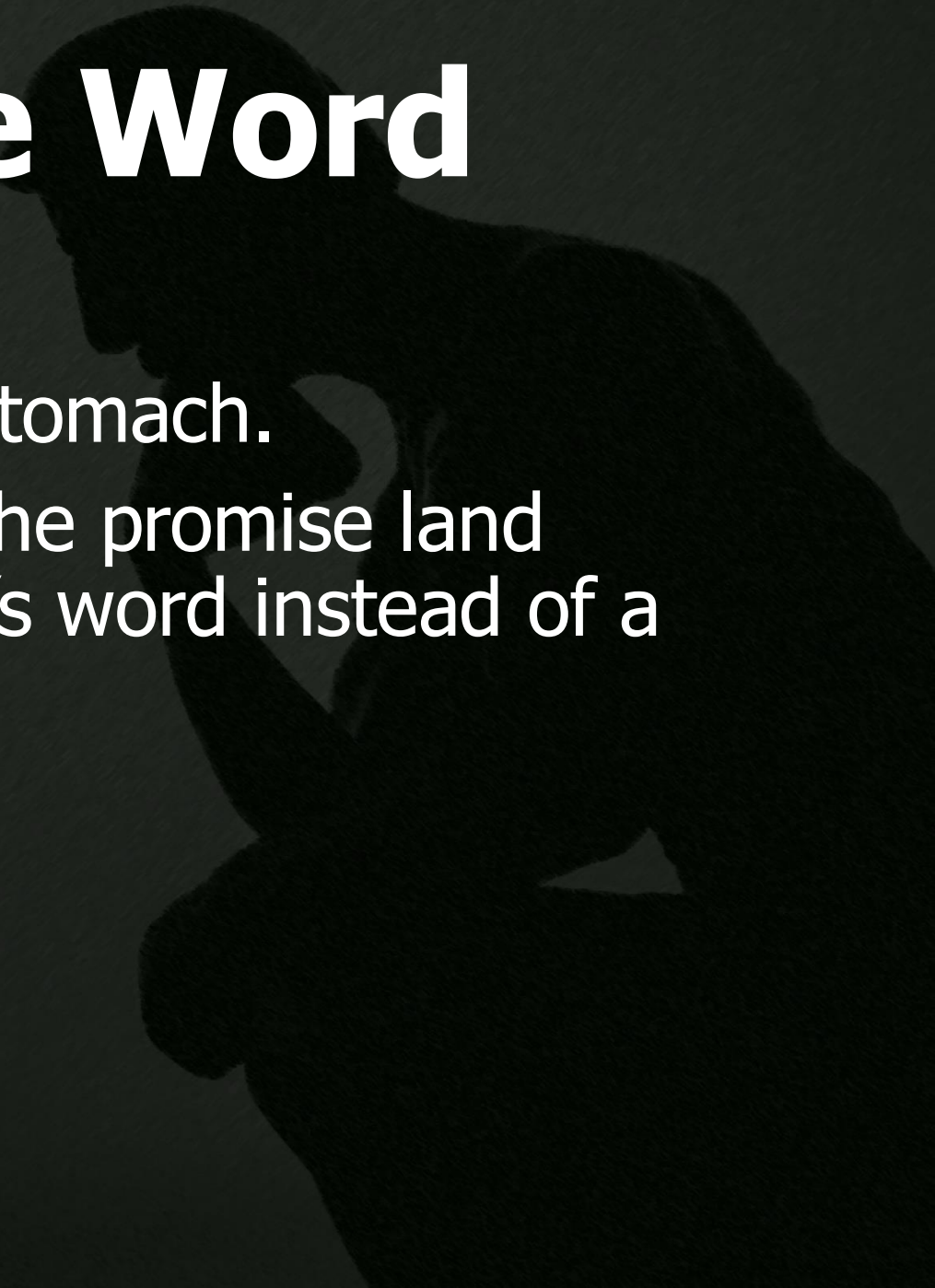
## Joshua 1:8

- The Israelites success in going into the promise land was based on the meditation of God's word instead of a strategic war plan.

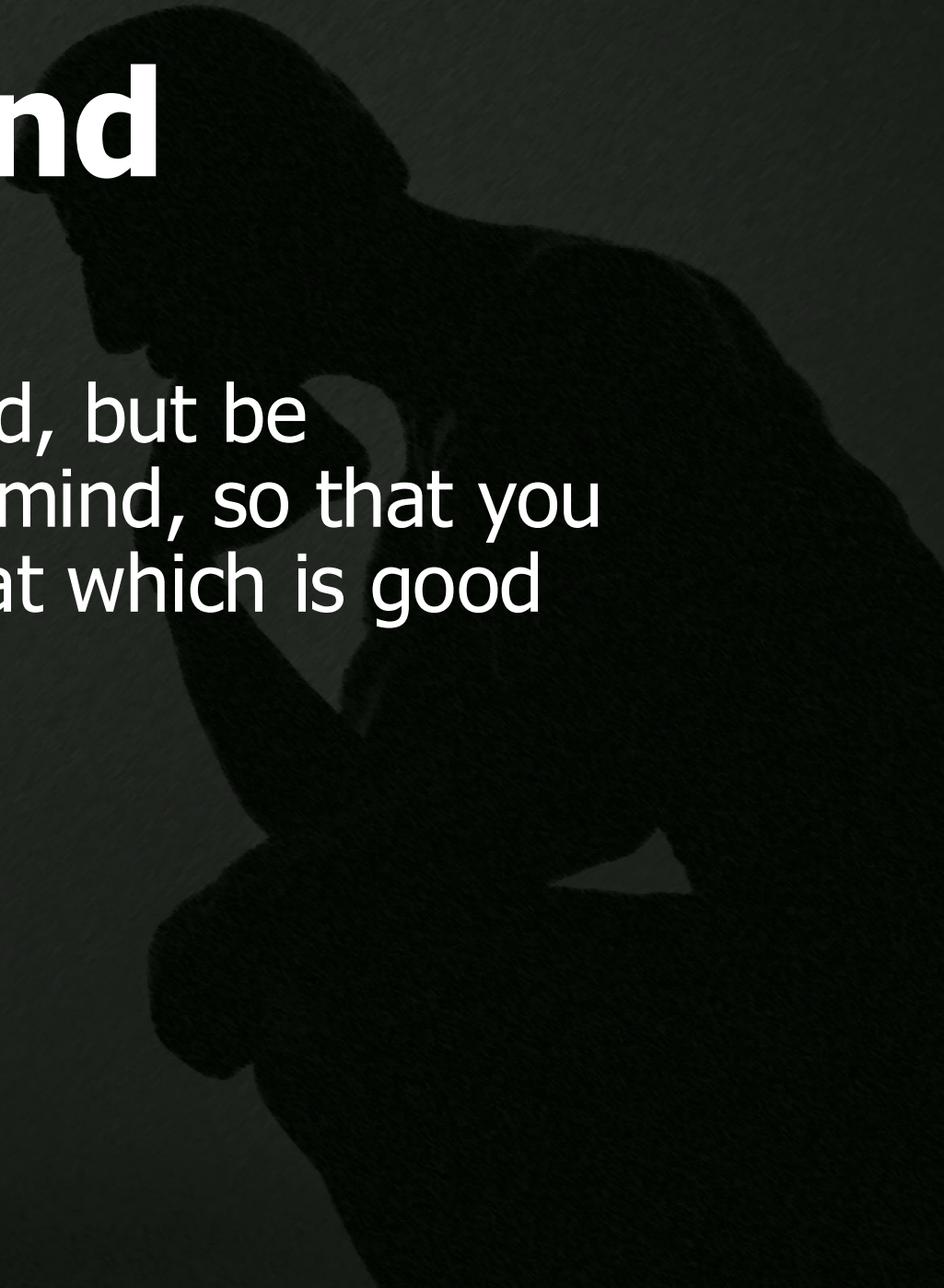




# 3. Renew your Mind

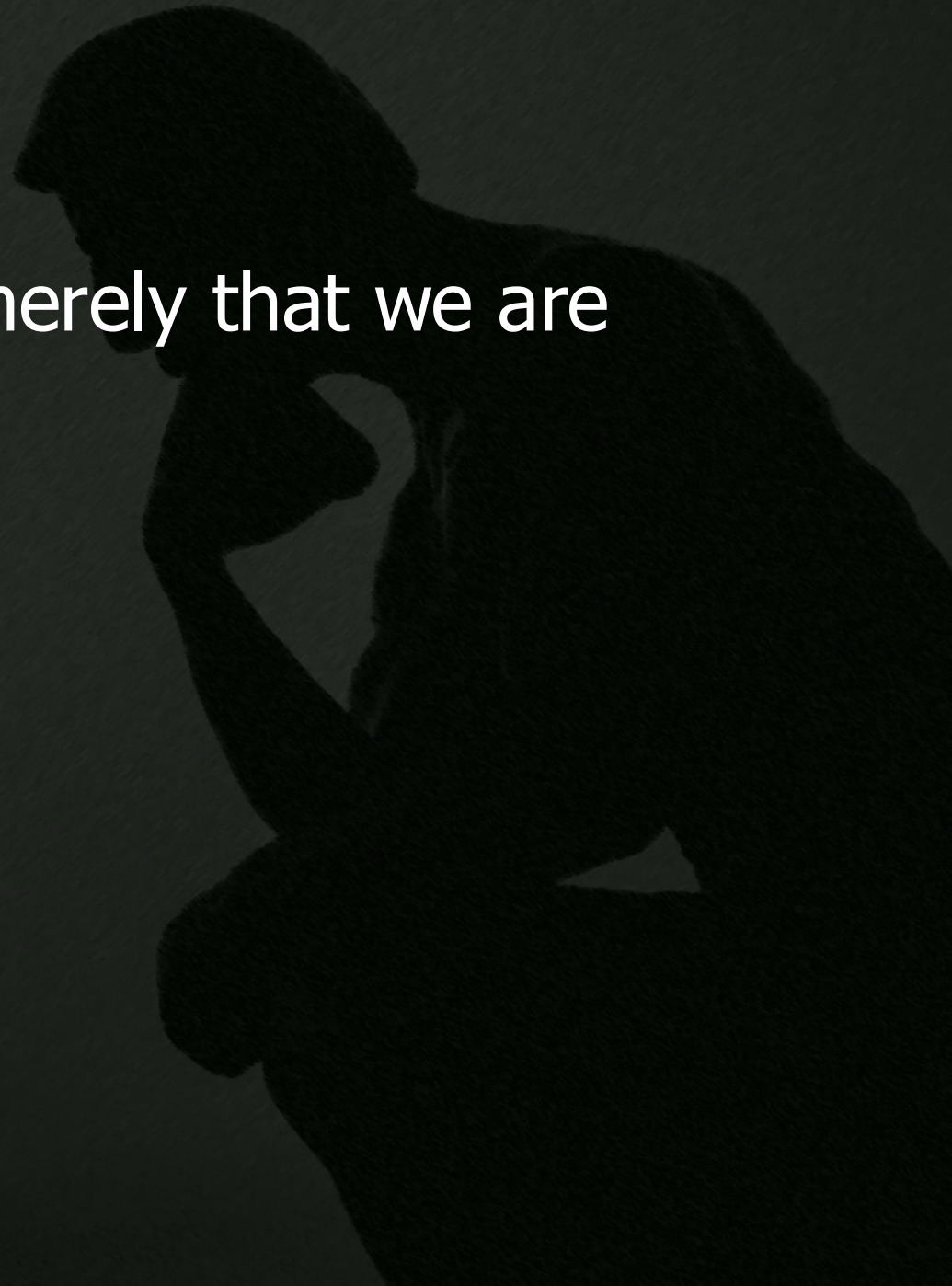
Romans 12:2

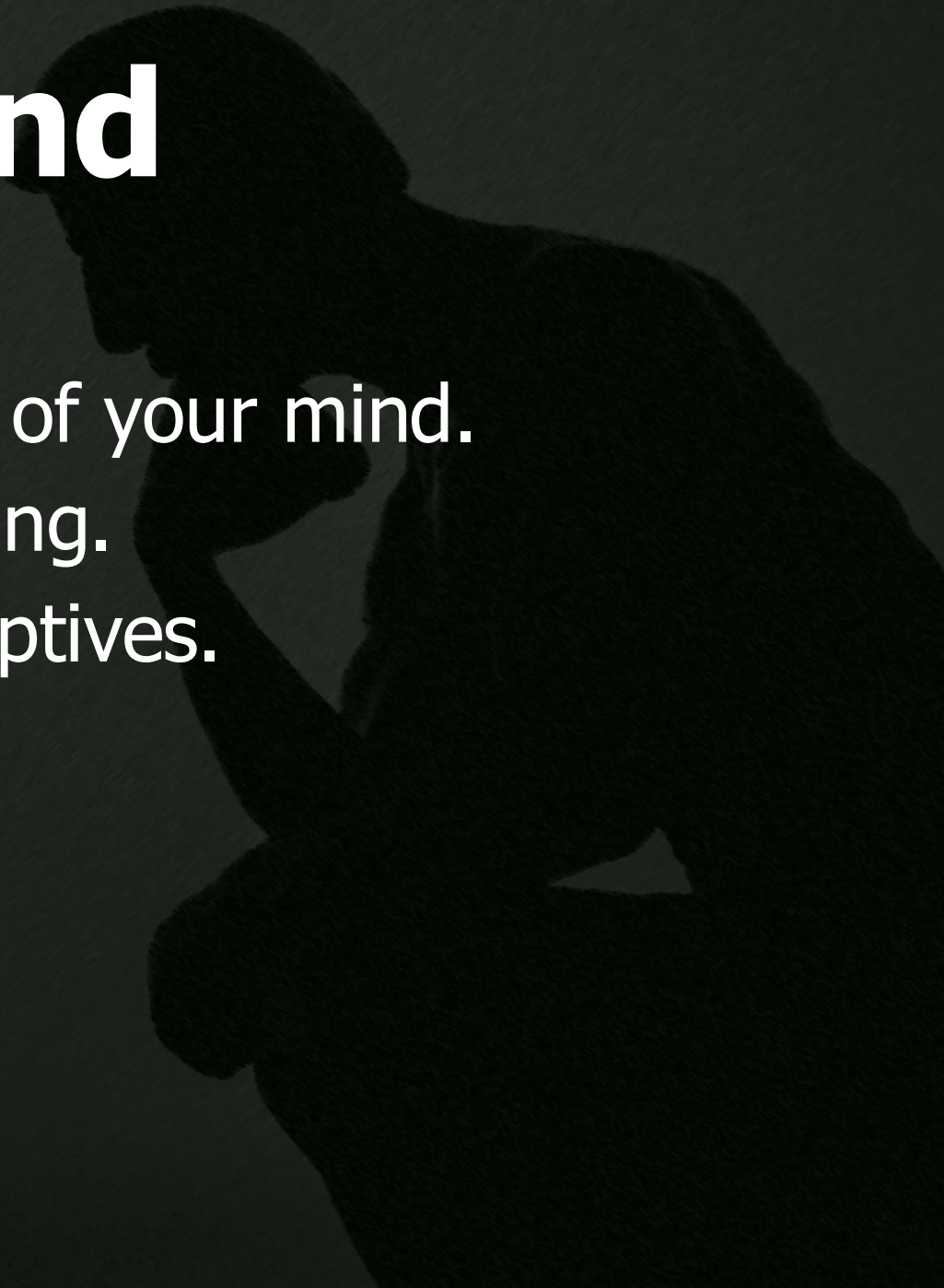


# 3. Renew your Mind

## Ephesians 4:23

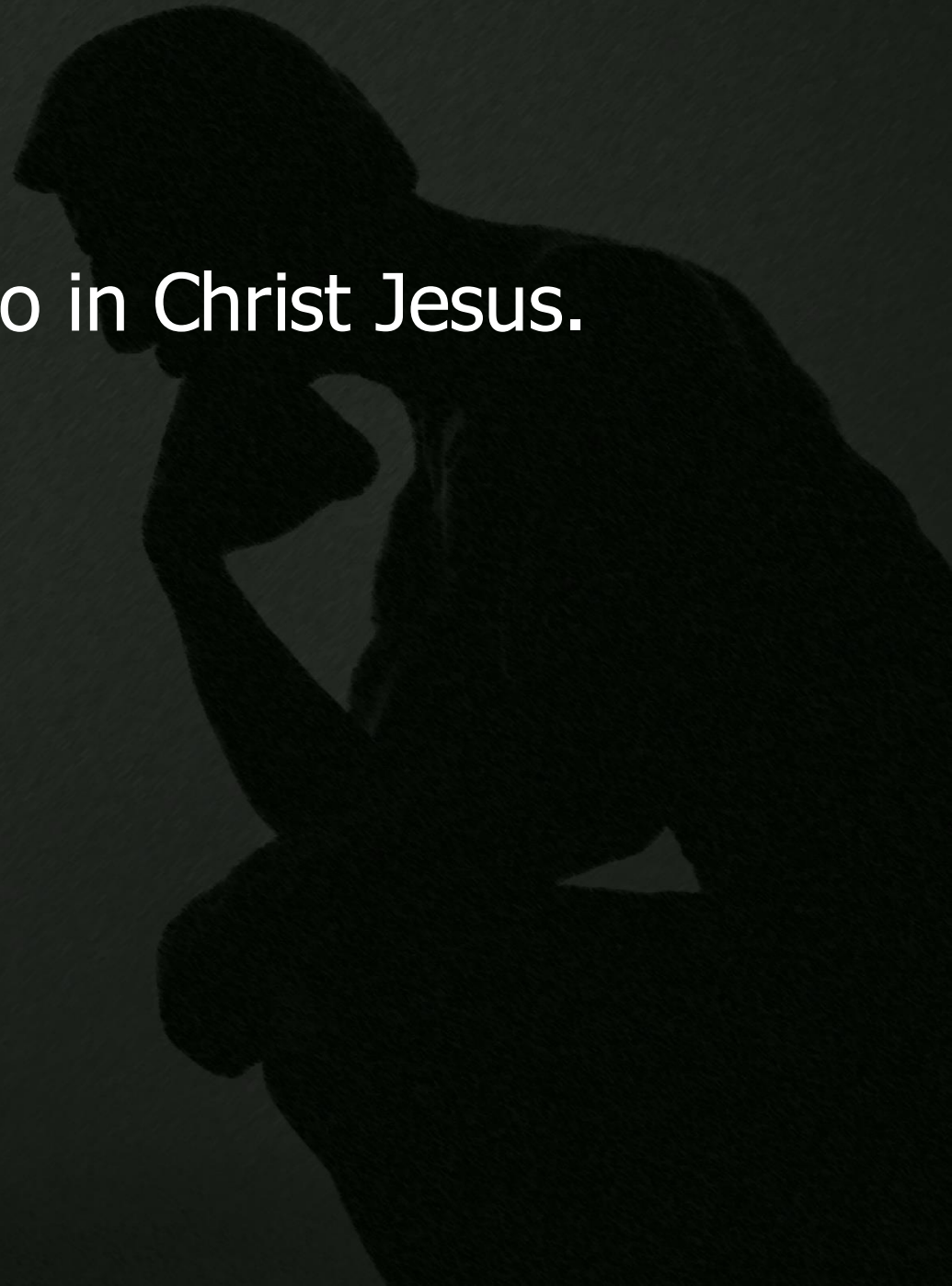
And that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind.

# Philippians 2:5

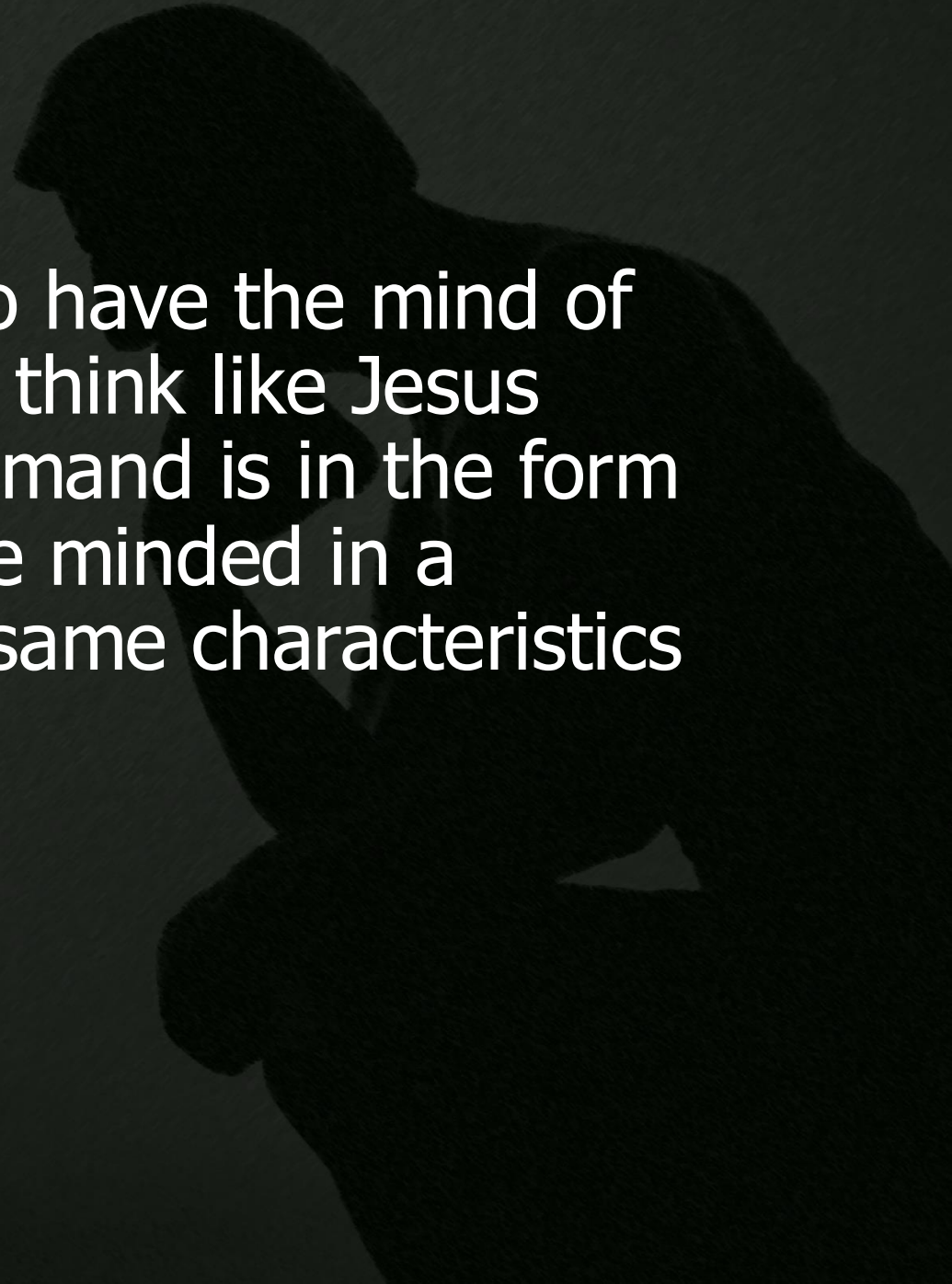
Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.
