<u>God's Word</u> – How He can speak to you

There are two definitions of Word

- Logos: the written Word of God
- Rhema: God speaking to us through His Word.

<u>God's Word</u> – How He can speak to you

"You must act upon the logos, the Bible, for God to speak, rhema, to you."

Romans 10:9-10 – If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord", and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

1. Have you accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior?

Psalms 25:5 – Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior and my hope is in you all the day long.

2. Have you received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit?

Luke 3:16 – John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of who's sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

<u>**Romans 8:26**</u> – In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.

<u>Ephesians 5:25-26</u> – Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with <u>the washing of water by the</u> <u>word.</u>

• We must let His Word cleanse us, by being obedient to what His Word is telling us.

• <u>Ephesians 5:25-26</u> – ...the washing of water by the word.

• He's not interested in how many hours we spend with him if we only hear and don't obey.
