2. ABOUT MOSES

Deuteronomy 34:10-12 - Since then, no prophet has risen in Israel like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face, who did all those signs and wonders the Lord sent him to do in Egypt – to Pharaoh and to all his officials and to his whole land. For no one has ever shown the mighty power or performed the awesome deeds that Moses did in the sight of all Israel.

- That even 120 years is not very long.
- The Apostle Paul addressed it this way
 1Corinthians 9:26 So I do not run aimlessly; I do not box as one beating the air.

 - To bring people to Jesus.
 - To help a believer grow in their faith.

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH
- Exodus 25:8 "Then have them construct a SANCTUARY for me, that I may dwell among them..."

- An Order of Service.
- God established "Laws of Offerings".
- How to:
 - Approach God.
 - Offer Praise.
 - Ask for forgiveness of sin.

- Through the sacrifice of animals, by offering "things from the soil", and by payment in shekels.

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH
- The Principle of Giving "the first and best".
- Genesis 4:4 and Able also gave an offering to the Lord. He killed the **first-born** lamb from one of his sheep and gave the Lord the **best** parts of it. The Lord was pleased with Able and his offering.

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH
- The Principle of Giving "the first and best".
- If it's an animal "a male without defect".
- If it's grain "of the finest flour".
- "The first ripe fruit".
- "The best of the fresh oil and wine".

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH
- Concerning the priests.
- "Here, I Myself have also given you charge of My offerings, all the holy gifts of the children of Israel.
- "Whatever is set aside from the holy offerings the Israelites present to the Lord, I give to you ...".

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH
- God establishes the Tithe
- Numbers 18:21 "I give to the Levites (Priests) all the tithes in Israel ...".
- Verse 26 Speak to the Levites (Priests) and say to them, "When you receive from the Israelites the tithe ...".
- Tithe maasrah a tenth.

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH God establishes the Tithe
- Through Jesus, we are no longer bound by the Mosaic Laws (Laws of Offerings)
- Hebrews 10:12 Whereas Christ, having offered the one sacrifice (the all-sufficient sacrifice of Himself) for sins for all time, sat down (signifying the completion of atonement for sin) at the right hand of God (the position of honor), ...

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH
- God establishes the Tithe
- Yes, through Jesus, we were freed from The Law.
- But God established three other specific requirements for the Tithe.

- 3. THE FIRST CHURCH
- Three Other Specific Requirements:
- The principle of giving "the first and best".
- To provide for the lively hood of the Priest.
- To provide for the care of the Sanctuary.
- · They still exist and support is still through the tithe.
- It was God's command then and it's His command now.

• Exodus 25:8 – ... "According to all that I am going to show you as the pattern of the tabernacle and the pattern of all its furniture, just as you shall construct it."

- It's not mandatory
- It's given freely, willingly and from what you have.

God's Instructions

• Exodus 35:4-5 – Moses said to the whole Israelite community, "This is what the Lord has commanded: From what you have take an offering for the Lord. Everyone who is willing is to bring to the Lord an offering of gold, silver and bronze ...".

Exodus 35:20-29 Summarized

 Everyone who was willing and whose heart moved them came and brought an offering to the Lord for the work on the tent of meeting, for all its service and for the sacred garments.

4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE

A New Offering

Exodus 35:20-29 Summarized

They brought:

- Gold jewelry of all kinds.
- Blue, purple or scarlet yarn, fine linen, goat hair, ram skins and other durable leather.

4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE

A New Offering

Exodus 35:20-29 Summarized

They brought:

- Silver, bronze and acacia wood.
- Onyx stones and other gems.
- Spices and olive oil.

- 4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE The materials; where did they come from?
- Exodus 12:35-36 The Israelites did as Moses instructed and asked the Egyptians for articles of silver and gold and for clothing. The Lord had made the Egyptians favorably disposed toward the people and they gave them what they asked for; so, they plundered the Egyptians.
- God is in control and will provide.

- 4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE
 The Talent
- Exodus 35:25-26 All the women who were gifted artisans spun yarn with their hands, and brought what they had spun of blue, purple and scarlet, and fine linen. And all the women whose hearts stirred with wisdom spun yarn of goats' hair.

- 4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE
 The Talent
- Exodus 36:1 "... every gifted artisan in whom the lord has put wisdom and understanding, to know how to do all manner of work with the service of the sanctuary, shall do according to all that the Lord has commanded."

4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE
The Talent

The Israelites **freely** and **willingly** gave of their Time and Talents.

4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE

Proverbs 27:19 – As water reflects the face, so ones' life reflects the heart.

- 4. THE BUILDING OF THE TABERNACLE In the Bible, the term "heart":
- Is used to describe our desires, hopes, interests, ambitions, dreams and affections.
- It's what motivates us what we love to do and what we care about the most.
- So, you see, what's in our heart is what we really are.

- It's a decision
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
