#### Colossians 3:12 (TPT)

"You are always and dearly loved by God! So, robe yourself with virtues of God, since you have been divinely chosen to be holy. Be merciful as you endeavor to understand others, and be compassionate, showing kindness toward all. Be gentle and humble, unoffendable in your patience with others."

### Introduction:

- In Colossians 3:12, the apostle Paul offers us a spiritual wardrobe checklist.
- Just as we choose our physical attire for the day, we are called to "get dressed" in these virtues, which reflect our identity as God's chosen and beloved.

## Reflection

#### A Divine Wardrobe:

- Compassion:
  - Compassion is like a warm, comforting sweater.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  It covers you in empathy and motivates you to help those in need.
- Kindness:
  - Kindness is your favorite pair of well-worn jeans.
  - It's comfortable and makes you feel good while spreading positivity to others.
- Humility:
  - Think of humility as your essential undergarment.
  - It's the foundation for all the other virtues, keeping you grounded and open to God's guidance.
- Gentleness:
  - Gentleness is like a soft, soothing scarf.
  - It offers comfort and warmth in your interactions with others, even in challenging situations.
- Patience:
  - Patience is like sturdy, reliable shoes.
  - They help you walk the path of life without stumbling, allowing you to endure difficulties with grace.

#### Wearing God's Virtues:

- Just as we make deliberate choices about our physical attire, we must make intentional choices to put on these virtues every day.
- When we clothe ourselves with these qualities, we become walking testimonies of God's love and grace.

## **Prayer:**

Heavenly Father, we thank You for clothing us with these virtues. Help us to remember that our spiritual attire is just as important as our physical clothing. May our lives reflect the compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience that come from being Your chosen and dearly loved people. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.
