Robed in Christ: Clothed with a Heavenly Identity

Galatians 3:26-27 (TPT)

"You have all become true children of God by faith in Jesus Christ! Faith immersed you into Christ, and now you are covered and clothed with his life. And we no longer see each other in our former state—Jew or non-Jew, rich or poor, male or female—because we're all one through our union with Jesus Christ."

Introduction:

Today we will explore the profound message found in Galatians 3:26-27, where we are reminded of our identity as children of God, robed in Christ.

Reflection

 - His sacrifice on the cross covers our sins, making us clean before God.

• Robed in Love:

- We are also robed in Christ's love.
- His love becomes our motivation to love others, just as He loved us.

• Robed in Purpose:

- Being robed in Christ means we share in His purpose.
- We are called to follow His example, to bring light to a world in need of His grace.
