## Romans 12:2 (MSG)

"So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you."

### Introduction:

In a world that often pressures us to conform, Romans 12:2 calls us to be different, to stand out for Christ. Let's explore how we can be dressed for the occasion of living a transformed life.

- Consider how you can actively renew your mind through prayer, studying God's Word, and seeking His guidance.

### Discovering God's Will:

- As we are transformed, we gain the ability to discern and follow God's good, pleasing, and perfect will.
- Reflect on times when your transformed mind led you to God's will in your life.

## Prayer:

Heavenly Father, we thank You for the call to be different from the world's patterns. Help us to resist conformity and embrace transformation through the renewing of our minds. Guide us in discovering Your good, pleasing, and perfect will for our lives. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.
