

A Thousand Ordinary Yeses

"A generous life isn't one big moment. It's a thousand bold, ordinary yeses."

BIG IDEA Bold generosity isn't one dramatic moment. It's built out of a thousand small, ordinary yeses that each cost something, added up over a lifetime.

KEY POINTS

- 'Much' is always assembled out of 'little' (Luke 16:10).
- You will get weary of small good. Keep going; the harvest has a date (Galatians 6:9).
- God restocks your mercy every morning, so you never run on yesterday's supply (Lamentations 3:22-23).

SCRIPTURES

Luke 16:10 · Galatians 6:9 · Lamentations 3:22-23 · Proverbs 4:18

TODAY'S CHALLENGE Say yes three times today when you'd normally hesitate: the door held, the tab picked up, the text sent. Count them. Then do it again tomorrow.

REFLECT

1. What small yes do you routinely skip because it 'doesn't matter'?
2. Whose life have you watched get built out of ordinary yeses?

PRAY *Lord, I don't need a big moment. I need a faithful today. Give me three yeses, and the strength to say them again tomorrow.*
