

Small Hands, Bold Hearts

"Small hands, bold hearts: God multiplies whatever we're brave enough to release."

BIG IDEA God has never rejected a gift for being too small. He's only ever asked whether you'll release it. Small hands plus a bold heart is exactly what He multiplies.

KEY POINTS

- The miracle in John 6 started with a boy's lunch, released into Jesus' hands.
- The widow's two coins were 'more' than everyone else's, measured in boldness, not amount (Mark 12:43-44).
- Faithfulness with little is the doorway to much (Luke 16:10; Matthew 25:21).

SCRIPTURES

TODAY'S CHALLENGE Give the small thing you've been holding back because it felt insignificant: the five dollars, the fifteen minutes, the kind word. Release it and let God do the math.

REFLECT

1. What have you decided is 'too small to matter'? Who told you that?
2. What little thing could you put in Jesus' hands today?

PRAY *Jesus, here's what I have. It's not much, but it's Yours. Multiply it however You want. Make me faithful with the little so You can trust me with more.*

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
