GO TO THE BIBLE

- Open to Matthew 5:13-16.
- Here we see Jesus use two different metaphors to describe his followers. What does it mean to be the “salt of the earth” and the “light of the world”?
- Final words hold a lot of weight. Let’s look at Jesus’ last words to his followers in the gospel of Matthew. Read Matthew 28:16-20.
- Read 1 John 4:19-21.
- Read verse 21 again. What does this reveal about what it means to love God?

TALK ABOUT IT

- According to these passages, what is our role or duty as followers of Christ?
- We go together to share the hope that has been shared with us. Where in your current community can you practically share hope?
- In Act 2:47 it says, "And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved." Why does this matter?
- In what ways can you love others this week? Think about it through three contexts: your home, your job, and your church.

WHAT NOW?

- Spend some time talking in your group about what's next! If your group will continue – what have we done or talked about that could help guide how we spend our time together and who we serve together? As a group think of some practical ways you might be able to go together.
- If your group is finishing up – ask the same questions of individuals – what's next? Do you see a change or a next step to take on the horizon?
- Every one matters. At Calvary, we talk a lot about your one life. Take some time to think about the one life in your world that needs the hope of Jesus. As a group, pray for these names.
