- Choose at least four of these verses and read them aloud together:
 - John 13:34, Romans 12:10, Romans 14:13, Hebrews 3:13, Romans 15:7, Galatians 6:2, Ephesians 4:32, Mark 9:50, James 5:16, 1 Peter 4:8, Romans 13:8, Romans 12:15-16
- What do the verses you chose have in common?
- Go back to this passage we read the first week and re-read Acts 2:42-47.
- How do you see these 'one anothers' reflected in the group in this Acts passage?

TALK ABOUT IT

- What would a community look like if we all followed these verses - if we were to 'one another' together?
- Whether in churches, sports teams, families, workplaces - when have you seen people care for each other in this way in your own life? What did that look like?
- Why does it matter to try to live and love like Jesus with other people?
- We grow together to help one another live a Christ-centered life. What would you want this to look like?

WHAT NOW?

- We have two weeks left! Spend some time in your group talking about what's next. Maybe this group would like to continue meeting, maybe you help people find a new group, or perhaps your group continues but you arrange the leadership differently.
