**PURPOSE: JUDAH IS MORALLY CORRUPT AND WILL EVENTUALLY BE DESTROYED BY BABYLON**

Habakkuk is the only Old Testament book consisting entirely of a dialogue between God and a man.

- Habakkuk 2:4 - The just shall live by his faith.  
Same verse is quoted three times in the New Testament (*Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, Hebrews 10:38*)
