PURPOSE: JUDAH IS MORALLY CORRUPT AND WILL EVENTUALLY BE DESTROYED BY BABYLON

Habakkuk is the only Old Testament book consisting entirely of a dialogue between God and a man.

- Habakkuk 2:4 The just shall live by his faith.
 Same verse is quoted three times in the New Testament (Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, Hebrews 10:38)

 - Habakkuk 1:1-4 Why does God allow bad things to happen?
- II. The Prophet had a <u>vision</u>. (Watching Chapter 2)
 - Habakkuk 2:1
 - Jeremiah 33:3 Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.
