REVIVE US AGAIN

Ezekiel had 3 main visions:

1. Glory of God leaving the temple in Jerusalem. *Chapter 1*
 2. Corruption of idols in the temple. *Chapters 8-11*
 3. A new temple would be established. *Chapters 40-48*
- Isaiah 43:7 - Everyone who is called by My name, whom I have created for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him.”
 - 1 Corinthians 10:31 - Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

Can these bones live? *Ezekiel 37:3*

God tells Ezekiel to preach to the bones, for they need God's word. *Ezekiel 37:4-7*

- 2 Timothy 3:16-17 - All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- Philippians 2:13-16 - For it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.
