

The Book of 1 and 2 Kings is broken up in 5 major sections:

- 1. Solomon's reign and the Temple constructed. 1 Kings 1-11
- 2. Israel is split into two rival <u>kingdoms</u>. 1 Kings 12-16 (Northern Kingdom called Israel and Southern Kingdom called Judea)
- 3. How God tried to prevent the corruption of Israel by sending Kings and Prophets. 1 Kings 17–2 Kings 8
- 4. The road to exile. 2 Kings 9-17
- 5. <u>Destruction</u> of Israel and the temple while they have been taken to exile to the Babylonians in 586 BC. 2 Kings 18-25
 - 1 Kings 1:1-4
 - 1 Kings 2:1-4

Solomon's greatest moment in the <u>presence</u> of God. 1 Kings 3:5-14 What is wisdom?

If / then statements...

Solomon builds a <u>permanent</u> house of God. 1 Kings 6-8
God's presence from the Tabernacle → Temple.
Remember a Holy God dwelling among an unholy people.

Solomon's prayer was heard by God. 1 Kings 9:1-9
