Summary

The sermon focuses on the story of David bringing the Ark of the Covenant into Jerusalem from 1 Samuel 6. Pastor Chris emphasizes the importance of proper worship and celebrating God's presence, using the contrast between Uzzah (who died trying to steady the ark in his own strength) and Obed-Edom (whose household was blessed by hosting the ark). The message highlights how true worship requires humility, understanding of God's presence, and willingness to express joy openly.

This week, challenge yourself to have at least one 'mad minute' of praise each day - 60 seconds of unrestrained worship and thanksgiving to God. Notice how this practice affects your perspective and relationship with God throughout the day.
