John 4:4-8 In a small Samaritan town known as Sychar, Jesus and His entourage stopped to rest at the historic well that Jacob gave his son Joseph. It was about noon when Jesus found a spot to sit close to the well since He was thirsty, while the disciples ventured off to find something to eat.

Intentional: adj, done on purpose, deliberate.

1. Be Intentional with the people around you.

John 4: 8-9 From His vantage, He watched as a Samaritan woman approached to draw some water. Unexpectedly He spoke to her. Would you draw water, and give Me a drink? (Woman): I cannot believe that You, a Jew, would associate with me, a Samaritan woman; much less ask me to give You a drink. Jews, you see, have no dealings with Samaritans.

2. Be Intentional with the gift you possess.

John 4:10 Jesus replied, "If you only knew who I am and the gift that God wants to give you, you'd ask me for a drink, and I would give you living water."

3. Be intentional with how you see each day.

John 4:21 Believe this: a new day is coming—in fact, it's already here.

4. Be intentional with what satisfies you.

John 4:31-32, 34 The disciples were urging Jesus to eat the food they had bought. But Jesus told them, "I have eaten a meal you don't know about." (vs 34) I receive My nourishment by serving the will of the Father who sent Me and completing His work.
