 Take the last few minutes of your time in prayer to let your heart and mind rest on this truth, that "Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice."

#### Wisdom

Cherishing and Discerning the Truth in Love

- 1. Read Acts 7:51-60; 1 Corinthians 4:9-13; Revelation 11:1-10. In these passages we see the cost of opposing the world by speaking the truth of the gospel, first with Stephen, then with Paul, and then the two witnesses who are symbols of the church. How have you perhaps either experienced or avoided the cost of speaking the truth of the gospel?
- 2. Read Daniel 10:10-14; 2 Corinthians 4:4; Ephesians 2:2; 6:12; Colossians 2:8. These passages tell us that the "world" is an organized system with a "prince" who governs through "elementary principles" that enslave, and that often this worldly kingdom stands with and behind human institutions (e.g. governments, organizations, etc.). How can we as Christians recognize these powers and what does it look like for us to oppose them, especially in light of John 18:37?

## Compassion

Moving Toward the Poor, Marginalized, and Broken in Love

 What does compassion look like when we are called as Christians to speak the truth?

#### Reconciliation

Repentance and Forgiveness for the Sake of Love

1. How have you been tempted to pursue a form of reconciliation that denies the truth, i.e. how have you sought peace with others by avoiding painful truths?
