RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **WELCOME** families and help them feel comfortable. Please have one volunteer remain at the counter until after the worship music to welcome late arrivals.
- Ask *new* parents to fill out the **FORM** on the front counter. Place the form with the child's diaper bag. After service, *please put the form in my mailbox.*
- Attach the child's **NAME TAG** to the back of their shirt and the other tag to their diaper bag. Be sure to collect these tags when parents pick them up.
- Give parents a **PAGER** and write down the number. Contact parents as needed.
- Please keep all **SHOES OFF** of the play mat. This will help it last longer.
- Fill out a **NOTE TO PARENTS** card for each child and send it home with parents.
- **CLEAN** toys that have been put in mouths. There is a tub on the counter for toys that need to be cleaned. Depending on the toy, please wash or spray with disinfectant (located above the sink) and allow to dry in the dish rack.
- **TIDY** the counters and discard left behind coffee, snacks, bulletins, etc.
- **VACUUM** play rooms. **SWEEP** or wipe down any messes made on the playmat.
- Please empty the **GARBAGE** and take it to the dumpster! **THIS IS ESSENTIAL!**
- As you leave, please go over the checklist by the door and turn off the **LIGHTS**.
