THIS MORNING... WE CONTINUE OUR STUDY IN JAMES ...

- By exploring practical Christian living...
 - ➤ At the *Crossroads of Culture*.

LISTEN... THERE ARE A LOT OF PEOPLE...

- Who name drop Jesus...
 - > But their lives don't reflect that they actually know Jesus!
- The reflection looks more like culture than Christ.

SO... JAMES...

- Highlights what Genuine Faith looks like...
 - > Thru practical daily living!

REMEMBER...

- We've seen six-ways to identify genuine FAITH so far:
 - 1) Response to trails (James 1:2-8)
 - 2) Compliance to God's mission (James 1:22-25)
 - 3) Worship that works (James 1:26-27)
 - 4) Affections that are fair (James 2:1-13) avoiding sinful partiality!
 - 5) Faith that bears fruit (James 2:14-20)
 - 6) Talk that has been transformed (James 3:1-12)

NOW TODAY...

- We close out chapter #3...
 - ➤ Where James says, "prove it!"

- o What kind of wisdom are you living out?
 - Is it from the Lord (OR) is it from culture?

I THINK MANY TIMES...

- Well-meaning Christians can get confused about this.
 - That's why this portion of (James) is so important.

OK...

HERE'S WHAT THE TEXT SAYS:

- Read (vv.13-18) NLT

HERE'S WHAT WE'RE TO UNDERSTAND:

- a) Wisdom from God... looks like this (v.13) NLT:
 - i. Honorable living = Not pretending & hiding behind a facade.
 - ii. Good works = Habits & practices with a lasting value.
 - iii. Humility =
- b) Wisdom from the world... looks like this (v.15) NLT:
 - i. Earthly = Practices that only have a temporary value.
 - ii. Sensual (gratification of senses over moral standards) = the flesh.
 - iii. Demonic = Spiritually influenced by a force in opposition to God.

HERE'S THREE WAYS WE CAN APPLY IT:

IDEA #1 – WISDOM FOR SELF-EVALUATION:

TURN TO (Proverbs 26:13-28) NLT

- a) Are you being spiritually lazy? (vv.13-16)
 - i. Excuses (v.13)
 - ii. Lacking faith (v.14)
 - iii. Wasting resources (v.15)
 - iv. Avoiding common sense (v.16)

- b) Are you being spiritually foolish? (vv.17-28)
 - i. Complicating things (v.17)
 - ii. Damaging words LIES (vv.18-19)
 - iii. Discourse of doubt GOSSIP (vv.20-22)

iv.

REMEMBER...

- James says (3:13) that we are to "prove" or faith...
 - > By the way we live our lives!

IDEA #2 – WISDOM FOR SPIRITUAL LEADERS:

NOW...

- Capture this also from (v.13) NKJV
 - "understanding" OR "understand God's ways"
- This is the only time in the NT this Greek word is used...
 - ➤ And it speaks to skillfully applying God's word...
 - o To practical situations.

LESSON'S FOR LEADING:

(Proverbs 27:23) NLT

- a) Discover the flocks condition (John 21:15-17) NKJV
- b) Detect / restore the sick ones those faltering in the faith (Gal. 6:1) NLT
- c) Deter danger (John 10:12) NLT attack & scatter

IDEA #3 – WISDOM FOR THE WHOLE CHURCH:

(James 3:17-18) NLT

- The power & flavor of God's wisdom...
 - ➤ Shows up in how we transfer our faith to others.

IN THE CHURCH...

- God has given social interactions...
 - ➤ As the method of pouring into others.

TURN TO (Titus 2:1-8) NLT

- a) MEN are to be known for being... (v.2) & (v.6) NLT
 - i. Self-controlled
 - ii. Respectable
 - iii. Full of wisdom

IT IS ASSUMED...

- That the MAN will develop his wife as taught in (Eph. 5:29) NLT
 - That he will bring her to maturity by pouring into her.

THEREFORE...

- b) WOMEN are to be known for... (vv.3-5) NLT
 - i. Personal godly living foots steps of faith (Prov. 31:10-31) KJV
 - Faithful
 - Hard working
 - Good attitude
 - ii. Training younger women...
 - o To love husband by becoming a willing mutual participant.
 - o To live wisely (self-controlled / respectable / full of wisdom)
 - o To work in their homes (this is not dusting & cleaning)
 - Shopping / exercising / business owner / educated...
 - Priorities: Husband, kids, home

HOWEVER,

- May we all recognize that the point of (James)...
 - ➤ Is magnifying the DIFFERENCE...
 - o Between the wisdom of the world...
 - And the wisdom of those who live by FAITH!
