#### TODAY WE FINISH...

- The last of the seven letters to the seven churches!
  - And, no doubt, the most difficult letter of them all.
    - o (A scathing rebuke!)

## ~ THE HISTORY ~

## LAODICEA... (Grk. = Law - I - De - Coo's)

- Was located in a tri-city cluster next to Colossae & Hierapolis (map)
  - And their claim to fame was in three areas:
- 1) It had the strong banking system in the region (they had money)
- 2) It had a medical school that produced eye medicine (good health care)
- 3) It had booming clothing market (we would call them outlet malls)

#### THIS CITY...

- Was educated / healthy / & wealthy.

#### WHO NEEDS GOD...

- When life is so easy AND outward confidence is high!?!
  - ➤ (Humanity is blinded by the pacifying of needs.)
  - > (1 John 5:19) sway Rocked to sleep / blind to eternal matters

## SO THEIR INVOLVEMENT IN THE CHURCH...

- Was <u>perfunctory</u> carried out with minimum effort!
  - ➤ They knew enough to be saved...
    - o But they didn't live out saving faith!
      - They were lukewarm.

#### AND ALL THE PROBLEMS BEGIN RIGHT HERE!

## ~ *STUDY* ~

## (v.14) NLT

## Laodicea means:

- (Lao) Laity or people
- (Dicea) Decision or rule

#### IT WAS A CITY... WITH A CHURCH...

- Where the peoples wishes were lived out.
  - ➤ And NOT a church ruled by God!

## (1 Tim. 3:14-15) NLT

## HOWEVER... THE PEOPLE IN LAODICEA...

- Placed faith in their own strength & abilities!
  - > They had material wealth, but lacked spiritual life!
- They settled into a cultural-Christianity...
  - ➤ With an intellectual faith...
    - o But it was NOT a Biblical faith!

## **HERE'S THE LESSON:**

- Self-sufficiency... whether in the 1<sup>st</sup> Century or the 21<sup>st</sup> Century...
  - ➤ Always lead to a <u>diminished zeal</u> for God!

### OUR PRIMARY...

- Love / submission / & dependency is to be in Jesus!

#### SO... FROM THE BEGINNING OF THIS STUDY...

- We should know...
  - > That the only thing God accepts is 100% & nothing less.
- (Deut. 6:4-6) Passionate / exclusive / relationship w/ God
   (Acts 8:37) believe with all your heart

## UNFORTUNATELY AMERICAN CULTURE...

- (Like those in Laodicea) compartmentalizes Jesus.
  - ➤ He's only part of what a cultural-Christian does.
    - o A Biblical faith is an ALL-IN faith in Jesus!

## NOW...

- Biblical scholars say Luke-Warmness is the identifying feature...
  - ➤ Of the church at the end of the age!

### SO THIS LETTER...

- Becomes highly personal for our time!

## (2 Tim. 3:1-5) NLT

#### LISTEN... APOSTASY...

- Is Christians rejecting revealed truth!
  - ➤ It different from error (which is ignorance).
- Apostasy departs from taking STEPS of faith...
  - ➤ BUT not the outward profession of faith!
    - o It's a falling away that starts in heart!

#### AND THE MARKS...

- Of a lukewarm Christian can be summed up in three words:
  - 1) Comfortable
  - 2) Complacent
  - 3) Convinced that nothing is wrong (blind).

## (vv.15-16)

## THE BACK GROUND TO THIS PORTION...

- Really helps us grasp what Jesus is saying!
  - Laodicea was rich, but it had a poor water supply.

#### SO WHAT WOULD HAPPEN...

- Is they **would draw** COLD water from Colossae (10-miles s/e)...
  - ➤ And HOT water from Hierapolis (6-miles n/e).

## THEY HAD WATER...

- But the struggle was when the water would arrive it was...
  - ➤ Lukewarm (undesirable)!

#### AND JESUS WAS RELATING LUKE-WARMNESS...

- To the spiritual poverty of their works!

(G#5513) Kle-A-Ros = Lukewarm

- A condition of the soul that fluctuates between...
  - > Torpor (inactivity) & fervor (passionate).

(John 5:39-40) NLT

#### THE SOBERING THOUGHT HERE...

- Is the church or the individual that does not take Jesus serious...

➤ Is in jeopardy!

Faith + Action = belief

## THIS CHURCH WAS FILLED WITH UNCONVERTED PEOPLE.

- They were social Christians... Christians in name only.
  - > They had professions of faith that were never lived out...
    - o Because the people were self-ruled (Laodicea)
      - And NOT submitted to Jesus' rule.

(v.17)

The faithful & true witness goes bluntly confrontational here...

- Commentators say this is a HARSH tone...
  - > But it's a manifestation of His love.

#### REMEMBER THEIR PHYSICAL STRENGTHS:

- 1) Strong banking system in the region (they had money)
- 2) Medical school that produced eye medicine (good health care)
- 3) Booming clothing market (we would call them outlet malls)

## JESUS SAID...

- You're spiritually bankrupt
  - You're spiritually blind
    - And you're spiritually naked

THIS VERSE...

- Disrobes the facade of self-righteousness!

## (v.18)

#### JESUS IS SAYING COME TO ME.

- Again He's playing off the things the Laodiceans...
  - > THOUGHT they were strong in:
    - o Riches (money)
    - o Clothing
    - o Eye medicine (health care)

## (v.19)

#### CLOSES...

- With God's love.
  - ➤ He's not willing that any should be destroyed

    (2 Peter 3:9) NKJV

## (v.20)

## JESUS IS AT THE DOOR KNOCKING...

- He wanted into the heart of this church (the individual people).
  - ➤ I've heard commentators describe this knock as:
    - o "... a heavy blow, knock with the knuckles"✓ (BLB) G#2925

It was a knock that was to be heard over the other noises...

- In other words Jesus was making Himself known.

# (Heb. 4:7)

"Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts."

God is knocking and wants your whole heart!

- An ALL-IN commitment!
  - > It requires restructuring your whole life.
    - And you're going to miss out on something!
