WE'LL... I'VE TITLED TODAYS MESSAGE: - "Where's The Love?"

TURN TO REVELATION 2... - And follow along as I read (vv.1-7) NLT

<u>~ INTRO ~</u>

TODAY...

- We see the first church Jesus speaks too...

The <u>Church of Ephesus!</u>

<u> POINT #1 – THE HISTORY:</u>

EPHESUS WAS A CHURCH...

- That had been faithful for 35+ years (Ephesians to Revelation).

AND NOW... JESUS IS...

- Speaking to this church personally...

> By telling the <u>pastors</u> what to say to the <u>congregation</u>.

EPHESUS...

- Was a city...

➢ Known for banking, trade, & religion.

• With a population of 250,000 people.

EPHESUS...

Held one of the seven wonders of the ancient world... *"The Temple of Diana"* – (fertility goddess).

- The temple was beautiful display of <u>marble-construction</u>.

POINT IS:

- Ephesus was a culturally rich city...

> And the church refused to compromise in it!

- However, the Christians lost their *FIRE*...

> As they drifted from a love for Christ.

~ <u>STUDY</u> ~

(v.1)

AS JESUS SPEAKS...

- He addresses 5-areas in the seven churches:
- 1) He addresses the Church & name of the City.
- 2) He reveals a certain aspect about Himself...
 ➢ As it relates to that local church: "these things says..."
- 3) He first shares a commendation where He can.
 ➤ (In two churches God can't find anything good to say)
 Sardis & Laodicea
- 4) He points out the sin.
 - (Two churches receive NO criticism... only good.)
 Smyrna & Philadelphia
- 5) He Admonishes & gives a promise.

NOW THESE <mark>SEVEN LETTERS...</mark>

- Can be applied in four ways:

1) Locally:

> The actual churches John wrote to in Asia.

2) **Ecclesiastically**:

Revealing the conditions in the church of any age.

3) **Personally**:

▶ "He who has an ear let him hear…" (v.7)

4) **Prophetically**:

Church history as it has unfolded over time.

CHURCH HISTORY:

Ephesus (AD 30-100) = Apostolic Era *Smyrna* (AD 100-313) = Martyr Era *Pergamos* (AD 314-590) = Compromised Era *Thyatira* (AD 590-1517) = Roman Catholic Era *Sardis* (AD 1517-1700) = Reformation Era *Philadelphia* (AD 1700-1900) = Revival Era *Laodicea* (AD 1900- present) = Worldly Era

AGAIN (v.1)...

WE SHOULD UNDERSTAND...

- That Jesus is intimately familiar with all that's happening...

➢ In HIS church!

POINT #2 – THE HEART PROBLEM:

(vv.2-3)

- <u>Works</u>:

➤ They were a church on the move!

- <u>*Labor*</u>: = They toiled to the point of exhaustion!

Labor can be a mark of good health.

- God calls men that are active.
 - > Think about **<u>David</u>** tending sheep...
 - Or the <u>disciples</u> that were at work fishing.
- God uses active people!

BUT GOD DOESN'T WANT PEOPLE...

- Serving out of the wrong motivation.
 - Out of religious burdens working for favor (Gal. 3:3)
 - Out of obligation (2 Cor. 9:5)
 - Out of selfish ambitions (3rd John 9-10)

AND THIS WAS THE PROBLEM...

- The church was struggling with!

It was action for God, BUT missing a love of God!

HOWEVER...

- They were getting some things right.

(v.2b)"... that you cannot bear those who are evil."

THEY UNDERSTOOD...

- The three "R's"...
 - Reject a divisive (heretical) man (Titus 3:10)
 - Restore those who have fallen into sin (Gal. 6:1)
 - Reconcile men to God (Eph. 2:16)

(v.4)

NOW WE GET TO THE PROBLEM...

- They had lost their intimacy with Christ!

> BUT everything still looked good on the outside.

(v.4)

"left your first love"

- This is a verse that is **<u>often misquoted</u>**...

- ➢ By saying, "you have <u>LOST</u> your first love"
- *Left*: This describes a motion moving from higher to lower condition... - In three steps:
 - 1) Neglect = Forgetting the habit / pattern / discipline.
 - 2) Abandon = You're no longer trying... it's a lost priority.
 - 3) Desert = Stepping away because there's no longer an interest.

SO WHAT'S THE REMEDY?

POINT #3 – THE HEALING:

(v.5a)

<u>*Remember*</u> – (Thought) Consider how you once followed God!?!

(Excuses are NOT allowed: Yea, but I'm older now!)

<u>*Repent*</u> – Change of attitude & change of conduct.

Bad attitudes show up when God's work becomes a burden
 And we stop following with total commitment.

(Ps. 37:3) "Trust in the Lord and do good..."

- Which summarizes the idea of attitudes & actions.

<u>*Redo*</u> – We go back to the basics!

The first things we did when we got saved:

- > Prayer
- Reading the Bible
- Passionate worshipping
- Connecting & sharing life with newer / younger believers.

LISTEN...

- "If you return to your first work you will find your first love!"

(v.5b)

HOWEVER...

- If repentance didn't happen...

Removal would.

HOW MANY PEOPLE HAS GOD REMOVED...

- For the health of His church?

▶ I don't know... BUT this is scary for sure!!!

<u>Nicolaitans</u> =

- 1) Irenaeus (late 2nd century) said, this group led lives of <u>unrestrained</u> <u>indulgence.</u>
- 2) Hippolytus (3rd century) said this group was associated with the Gnostics... who <u>denied Christ preeminence</u>.

~ IN CLOSING ~

ARE YOU DENYING CHRIST!?!

ARE YOU LIVING A LIFE... - That's reflective of the Grace of God!?!

YOUR SIN'S TODAY...

May not be what you've done...But what you're NOT doing!

YOU MAY HAVE EXTERNAL AGREEMENT WITH TRUTH... - But there's NO internal obedience!

THESE BELIEVERS LEFT THEIR FIRST LOVE...

SO TOO... YOU MAY HAVE ALL THE RIGHT FACTS... - But you've stop living by faith!

YET... THE QUESTION IS...

- In light of what God sees...

➢ Will you acknowledge it...

• And change directions!?!

(v.5b)

If repentance didn't happen... - Removal would.
