- Turn to the book of (James 2:14-26)

~ LET'S PRAY ~

NOTE TAKERS...

- I've titled today's message: "The Practical Side of Faith"

~ *INTRO* ~

TODAY OUR STUDY...

- Takes us beyond **theory** & **ideas** of walking with God...
 - > AND into how a believer lives as a Christian.

THIS PORTION OF JAMES...

- Is all about results!

CHURCHES ARE A GREAT PLACE...

- To bring hurting people.
- But Church are also a great place...
 - > To find healed people!
 - o The results of genuine faith.

JAMES IS TECHING US...

- That real faith is visible!

SO... CATCH THIS:

- The whole point in these verses today...
 - ➤ Is to encourage an authentic faith...
 - o NOT to stir up doubts about one's salvation!

JAMES...

- Is teaching us there are *expressions* that come with true faith.
 - > AND what the *evidence* of true faith looks like.

"The Practical Side of Faith!"

IDEA #1 – QUESTIONS ABOUT FAITH: READ (v.14) NLT

THIS VERSE...

- Presents us with two **faith probing questions**:
 - a) What good is faith without actions? (no use)
 - b) Can that type of faith save anyone? (no)

SO...

- It's super important for us to wrap our minds around this.
 - ➤ We MUST understand what he's teaching us.

LAST YEAR WE FINISHED...

- A year-long study in the book of Romans...
 - ➤ AND Paul taught us (in Jesus) we're *Justified!*

(de-ki-A-oo)...

- **Declared righteous** as in a legal proceeding.
 - ➤ That Is the "root of salvation!"
 - o Being saved by faith & nothing else.

BUT... MOVING FORWARD... THE PRACTICAL SIDE OF FAITH...

- James uses the same Greek word (*de-ki-A-oo*) (v.21)
 - ➤ Which means to **Demonstrate as righteous**...
 - This is the fruit of salvation after being saved.

POINT BEING...

- Without a ROOT there is NO FRUIT.
 - ➤ A faith that produces no fruit is NOT a saving faith!
 - o It's NOT a genuine faith.

<u>IDEA #2 – QUALITIES OF FAITH:</u> READ (vv.15-20) NLT

HERE IN THE NEXT SEVERAL VERSES...

- We learn about the qualities of faith in Jesus...
 - > The characteristics we've inherited!

Four Qualities of Faith:

1) (vv.15-16) Fruit from the root... Faith engages needs.

> We get involved when we see a need.

WHEN YOU SEE A MEMBER OF THE FAMILY...

- Suffering a need...
 - ➤ Those that CAN help SHOULD help!
 - o Faith engages!!!

BUT NOTICE (v.16)...

- James' example... says a dead faith does nothing more...
 - ➤ Than lip service = "Good bye and have a good day."
 - o I'll be praying for you!

*(1 John 3:17) NLT

- 2) (v.17) Faith shouldn't exist in a hidden bubble!
 - Faith is to be **expressed in outward actions**.
 - o (Our actions speak louder than our words).

THE IDEA...

- Is... genuine faith always has results!
 - ➤ If it doesn't...
 - o It's a DEAD faith.

A DEAD FAITH MEANS:

- Useless / ineffective / impotent
 - > It's a "phony-faith"
- 3) (v.18) Faith is NOT invisible, but prominent in your life.

THE IDEA...

- Applies to the person who says, "I have a private faith!"
 - This person says things like, "I keep my faith to myself."

AND THIS IS EXACTLY JAMES' POINT!

- To move the <u>ignorance</u>... (of a passive faith person)...
 - ➤ Into ACTION so God can use them.

- 4) (vv.19-20) Faith is not an intellectual exercise...
 - ➤ But it's an issue of the heart (Rom. 10:9).
 - Faith flows from the heart.

THE KEY HERE...

- Speaks to the intellectual.
 - ➤ This type of person has theology down...
 - o They know the Bible verses!

BUT THE COLLECTION OF FACTS...

- Has NOT penetrated the heart.
 - ➤ There's no effect on the practical movement of hands & feet.

HERE'S A LESON FOR LIVING:

- Accurate theology never replaces an obedient life.
 - We're called to be doers of the word & not forgetful hears.
 - \triangleright OR (v.19) that person is on the same footing as demons.

IDEA #3 - EXAMPLES OF FAITH: READ (vv.21-26) NLT

ABRAHAM...

- A guy that came to faith when he was 50-yrs old...
 - Living in the well to-do area of Mesopotamia.
 - He was a pagan worshiper of a moon god.
 - ➤ He was <u>Rich</u> / <u>Respected</u> /& <u>Religious</u>.

RAHAB...

- The prostitute from Jericho in the prime of beauty...
 - Was disgraced, despised, & had a discolored life.

BOTH OF THESE PEOPLE...

- Came to a real faith in the LORD...
 - And their faith was reflected in the lives they lived.
- *Their belief was tied together with a whole-life response!
 - Their faith was active & visible!

~ IN CLOSING ~

HOW DO I DO THAT?

By putting Jesus OVER Jeff.

(Ps. 37:3) says it by putting attitude & actions into motion!

EXAMPLE:

Suppose a person in your Digital-Discipleship group...

- Is going thru a setback...
 - And the kids needs clothes / food / haircut / etc.
 - o Don't say... "we will be praying for you"

James is saying that doesn't cut it.

- Put your faith into action & DO SOMETHING!

When there's opportunity...

- OR a need surfaces at church...
 - > Step up & step out!
