- Turn to the book of (James 4:11-17) NLT

~ LET'S PRAY ~

NOTE TAKERS...

- I've titled today's message: "Overcoming Our Corruption"

~ *INTRO* ~

NOW... AS WE CONTINUE OUR STUDY ...

- We've learned that practical Christian living...
 - ➤ At the *Crossroads of Culture...*
 - o Is the core message of James.

BUT... REMEMBER...

- James was a half-brother to Jesus...
 - And he was <u>antagonist</u> & <u>critical</u>...
 - o Toward the methods / message / & miracles of Jesus.
 - (John 7:3-5) NLT

HOWEVER...

- After James saw the resurrected Jesus (1 Cor. 15:7) NKJV...
 - ➤ He became a radical defender & supporter of the faith!

JAMES...

- Writes a NO non-sense BOOK...
 - ➤ About Christian living in a corrupt culture...
 - o And refers many times to the Sermon on The Mount.

HERE'S WHAT HE SAYS:

- Read (vv.11-17) NLT

HERE'S WHAT WE'RE TO UNDERSTAND:

a) Critical conversations don't produce obedience (vv.11-12)

b) Self-confident plans are NOT the way of faith (vv.13-17)

HERE'S TWO WAYS WE CAN THINK ABOUT THIS:

IDEA #1 – MY CONVERSATIONS: (vv.11-12)

(Proverbs 18:21)...

"Death and life are in the power of the tongue..."

IN OTHER WORDS... WE HAVE THE ABILITY...

- To build people up OR pull them down...
 - With the words that we use & the way we talk.

JESUS SAID...

"... The Father... has commanded me what to say AND how to say it."

(John 12:49) NLT

THIS IS A TRUTH FOR ALL CHRISTIANS!

- We need growth & development in *Emotional Intelligence*...
 - > By not "speaking evil against each other"

<u>Literally:</u> Fault-finding that destroy others!

AGAIN... JESUS SAID:

"Why do you look at the <u>speck</u> in your brothers eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye?" (Matt. 7:3) NKJV

WHY ARE YOU...

- Looking at a **smaller fault** in someone else's life...
 - ➤ When your issues are much greater!?!

A BALANCED APPROACH:

- i. (Eph. 4:29-31) NLT
 - We grieve the Holy Spirit when our words & ways...
 - o Become abusive to others.

ON THE OTHER HAND...

ii. (1 Thess. 5:19-22) NLT

- ➤ We *Quench* the Holy Spirit OR *stifle* God's influence...
 - o By rejecting the word of God over our lives.

MAYBE A FRIEND...

- Gives you a tough word... (In gentleness & respect)
 - > But you trip out & want to argue.

LISTEN... THE LANGUAGE OF FAITH...

- Should be expressed in:
 - a) By building others up

AND...

b) By our confidence in God's word

CONSIDER JOB FOR A MOMENT.

- He was a man going thru a season of sifting...

His faith was \underline{tested} to the verge of collapse = (Luke 22:31) NKJV

- ➤ AND God allowed three areas of his life to be touched:
 - 1) His finances business collapsed
 - 2) His family kids killed
 - 3) His health became a daily struggle

YET...

- Job continued to use the <u>language of faith</u> during this time of sifting...
 - ➤ And his confidence in God's word was unshakeable!!!
 - ➤ (Job 1:21) NKJV = Eternal perspective
 - ➤ (Job 13:15) NKJV = Submissive to God's will
 - \triangleright (Job 23:12) NKJV = Found strength in the word

SO... HERE'S THE LESSON FOR LIVING:

WHEN WE TALK TO...

- OR about... other Christians...
 - We need to think about our words first!

T – True

H – Helpful

I – Important

N – Necessary (saving from hardship of bad decision)

K - Kind

IDEA #2 – MY PLANS: (vv.13-17)

(Ruth 1:1)

- Elimelech & Naomi...
 - ➤ Are an example of people running...
 - O When circumstances got tough!

THEY LEFT BETHLEHEM (house of bread)...

- And moved to MOAB (toilet bowl).

RATHER THAN LIVING BY FAITH...

- They made plans that "seemed right" (Prov. 16:25) NLT
 - ➤ But fell outside of God's leading.
- In the long run it cost them dearly...
 - ➤ Suffering / death in marriage / & death of kids.

(Heb. 11:8-9) NLT

- A life of faith unfolds step-by-step & continues in faith!
 - ➤ It's submitted to biblical truth... (Ps. 119:105) NLT
 - o And the counsel of others... (Prov. 11:14) NKJV

POINT BEING:

- Self-confidence... wrestles the reigns of leadership...
 - > Out of the hands of God...
 - o And demands my-way right-now!!!
 - (Num. 11:4-15)

SATISFY MY PHYSICAL CRAVINGS...

- To the neglect of spiritual principals.
 - ➤ (Matt 4:2-4) NKJV
 - ➤ (Titus 2:4-5) NLT
