Prayer Request

I sent a more detailed prayer request in an email, but wanted to highlight a request that feels urgent here. We have never included homeschooling expenses in our support raising because our kids are enrolled in a public correspondence school that provides an allotment fund to use for these expenses. A judge in Alaska just ruled the allotment fund unconstitutional and everyone is currently scrambling to provide funding for the thousands of homeschooling families, including the House, Senate, and Court system. I realize this correspondence system is not found in many places in the country (Alaska is very unique for a variety of reasons that don't necessarily apply down south) and many people have opinions about this, but it really affects our family right now, especially our kids. I am just asking for three specific prayer requests right now and if you want to know more details, please email me.

- Pray that the House Bill regarding this passes.
- Pray for my peace of mind. This feels all consuming right now and I want to lay it at Jesus' feet, receive His peace, trust Him to take care of it all, and focus on serving the Lord at camp right now.
- Pray that our kids would be able to continue participating in their activities.
