LAUNCH WEEKEND FOR "LOVE FOR EVERY ONE"; MAY 6/7

We hope all of us at Pekin First will want to be in the procession to the altar during worship this weekend as we bring our gifts or pledges to present to our Lord. Cards and envelopes are available. Even if you've already pledged or given, we encourage you to fill out another card and be a part of the procession to the altar. (Our Financial Secretary Kathy knows that you've already pledged/given and she won't record it twice!)

There are thousands of ways to participate. Here are a few! After praying to God and submitting to His will, perhaps God is calling you to...

- Give a one-time gift by writing a check, giving online, or giving cash.
- Make a pledge by adding a percentage or two to your regular giving, as you move toward the tithe.
- Donate stock
- Donate your Required Minimum Distribution (tax relief with this one!)
- Give up eating out once a week, or once a month and donating the amount you would have spent! (You'll be amazed at how quickly that adds up. For a couple to eat out, conservatively it will cost about \$30.00. 30 times 52 weeks = \$1560!!! Times the 2 years of the campaign and your gift would be \$3,120!!!)
- Give up a cup of coffee per day, again it adds up.
- Have a bake sale and donate the income.
- Have a garage sale and donate the income.
- There are MANY more ways to participate.

I hope everyone got to see the video of "Pekin First through the years" which we showed at worship this past weekend. We believe it has this effect on people: "I love being a part of this church!" Or, "I want to be a part of this church!" If you'd like to see it, we'll send you the link. Just ask.

WHAT IS OUR PLAN GOING FORWARD?

It's entirely possible that after this weekend (May 6/7) we'll have enough gifts and pledges that we can begin the work and complete it in a matter of months. If not, we'll let the church family know how much has been given/pledged, and we'll then need to have a church conference to have a vote on how we'll prioritize the work. (What will be done first, second, third, etc.).

But what if MORE comes in than is needed!? We love that faith! We always have work which needs to be done, and people to help. We have the matter of a garage to house our vehicles (unfortunately we learned first-hand of the catalytic converter epidemic), the next step for Providence Place, and we actually cut out some of Miss Emmy's vision for the playground which we could re-instate if more than a total of \$595,000 comes in! Check out Exodus 36:6-7. That's when Moses had to tell the people to stop bringing gifts because they had more than enough to build the temple! What an incredible witness that would be for our people and for this community. I want to be a part of a church like that!!!
