LOVE FOR EVERY ONE CAMPAIGN

WE hope EVERY ONE will WANT to participate in some way. We recognize that we aren't all in the same economic position. We aren't asking for equal gifts, but equal sacrifice. We remember King David (actually just before he became king) telling Araunah, after Araunah had offered his "worship space" to David for free. David's response: "NO! I will not sacrifice to the Lord my God, that which cost me nothing." As you pray about participating, please make it a matter of your relationship with your Lord. What gift is God calling for, from you? What gift will cause you to NEED to depend on your Lord? What gift will cause you to go to greater depths of discipleship?

SCHEDULE: From now until May 6/7, please pray daily, "Lord, how do You want to love every one, through me?" At worship on May 6/7, we're inviting all of us to present to the Lord at the altar our sacrificial gift to God, for the Love For Every One campaign. (We'll supply a commitment card).

GOAL: We hope that sufficient gifts and pledges will come in so that we can get the work all accomplished in a matter of months. The Campagin goal is \$595,000, and we have about \$70,000 on hand.

PLAN: After May 6/7 we'll assess where we are. Hopefully, we'll have enough on hand and pledged to do the projects. If not, we'll have to decide priorities going forward. That would be a church decision, after recommendations by the Building Committee.
